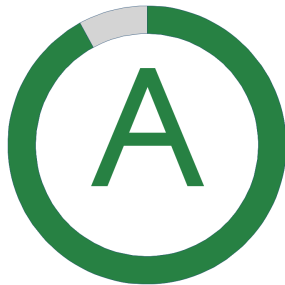

## Overall Performance Details

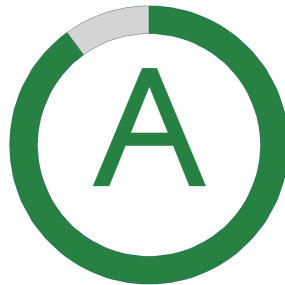

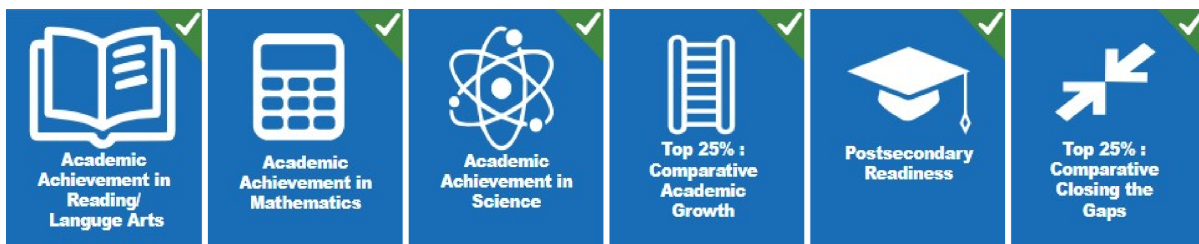
