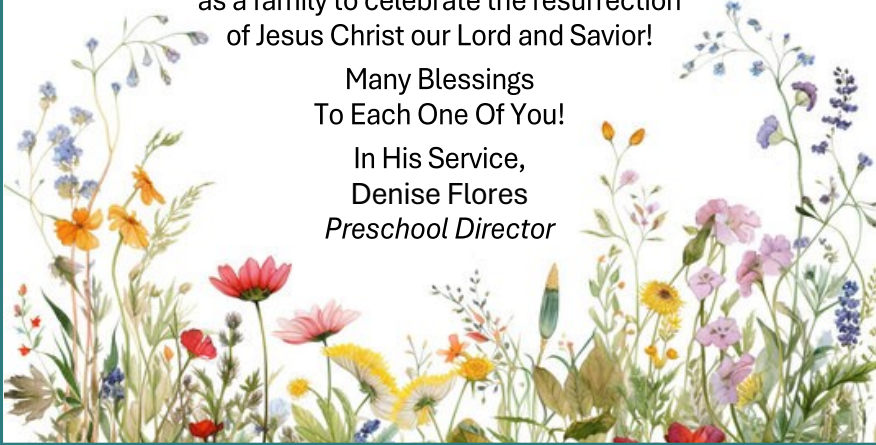
## Happy Spring!

## Tiny Humans, Big Emotions

When a preschooler is upset, their brain is basically throwing a tiny storm—logic takes a back seat, and big feelings take the wheel. That’s where cool-down time comes in. Giving your child space to calm their body helps their nervous system reset so their “thinking brain” can come back online.

Developmental research shows that young children can’t self-regulate on their own yet—they borrow calm from trusted adults. A short, predictable cool-down (think cozy corner, deep breaths, a hug, or squeezing a pillow) teaches them that feelings are safe and manageable, not something to fear or rush through.

Over time, these moments build lifelong skills like emotional regulation, problem-solving, and resilience—all while helping everyone get back to playing, learning, and connecting a whole lot faster.

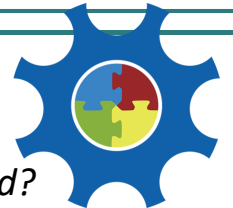
