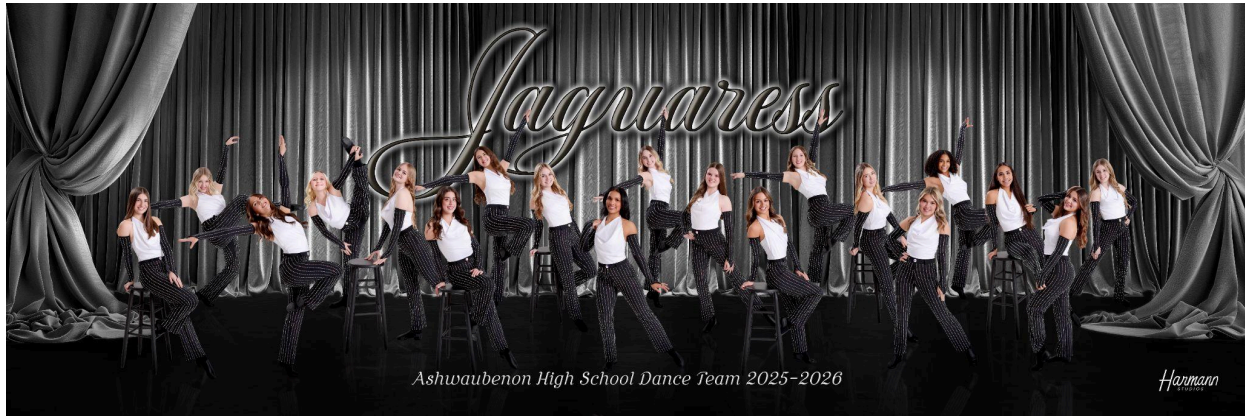

The Ashwaubenon Jaguaress Dance Team is an award-winning athletic program at Ashwaubenon High School built on a tradition of high standards and expectations. The purpose of the program is to cultivate a love of dance, develop self-discipline, promote excellence in teamwork, and foster a strong sense of responsibility to one another, to the program, and to the Ashwaubenon High School community.

The Jaguaress Dance Team is a competitive team comparable to all varsity sports at Ashwaubenon High School. Team members are trained in multiple styles of dance and are expected to demonstrate commitment, discipline, and dedication throughout the season.

### **Primary Competitive Focus**

The team's main competitive routines include:

- **Pom** – Emphasis on synchronization and the visual effect of poms.
- **High Kick** – Emphasis on the quality, precision, and visual impact of kicks.
- **Jazz** – Emphasis on technical skill, style, and execution.

### **Secondary Focus (Selected Years)**

Based on coaching discretion, the team may also perform:

- **Hip-Hop** – Sharp, synchronized choreography in a street or hip-hop style.
- **Fall Football Routine** – Designed for crowd appeal and performance on a football field.
- **Sidelines** – Choreography adaptable to various songs and settings.

### **Season Commitment**

Dancers are required to make a three-season commitment during the school year: Summer, Fall, and Winter.

The team performs at:

- Varsity football and basketball games
- Homecoming Pep Assembly and Parade
- All post-season playoff games for football and basketball

The competitive portion of the season begins in November, with competitions held throughout the winter.

### **WACPC Competition**

The team competes in Regional and State events hosted by WACPC (Wisconsin Association of Cheer/Pom Coaches).

At the conclusion of the season, the team competes at the WACPC Regional Competition, where up to three routines may be performed. Qualifying routines advance to the WACPC State Dance Competition, held the first weekend in February.

In 2026, the team was named:

- Division 2 Kick Northern Regional Champions / Division 3 Pom Northern Regional Runners-Up / Division 2 Jazz - 3rd Place



The Ashwaubenon Dance Team has earned 10 State Championship titles in school history:

- 2026 – Division 2 Kick / 2025 – Division 2 Kick / 2023 – Division 2 Kick / 2022 – Division 2 Kick / 2021 – Division 2 Pom / 2019 – Division 2 Kick and Division 2 Pom / 2018 – Division 1 Kick / 2014 – Division 2 Pom / 1988 – Novelty

### **Out-of-State and National Competitions**

The team has also competed at prestigious out-of-state and national competitions, including:

- DX Americup – Minneapolis, MN / Contest of Champions – Orlando, FL / Dance Team Union - Orlando, FL / NDA – Orlando, FL

In 2026, the team advanced to finals at NDA Nationals, placing 4th in Large Kick and 11th in Large Pom.

Additional national achievements include:

- 2022 Contest of Champions – Small Novelty/Character Division Champions
- 2017 Contest of Champions – Small Pom Champions
- 2018 DX Americup – High School Pom and High School Kick Champions, and Grand Champion Overall

### **Ashwaubenon Dance Invitational**

In 2011, the Jaguaress Dance Team hosted the first Ashwaubenon Dance Invitational at Ashwaubenon High School. Held annually on the first Saturday in December, the competition has grown to host up to 134 teams and is now considered one of the largest and most prestigious dance competitions in Wisconsin.

### **Team Expectations and Philosophy**

There are many opportunities available to students in high school. Joining the Jaguaress Dance Team is a significant time commitment; however, for many, the experience is well worth it.

Dancers develop time management skills, form lasting friendships, and are challenged both physically and mentally. The team includes individuals with a wide range of experience levels—from highly trained dancers to those new to dance. One of the strengths of a high school dance team is the ability to mold diverse individuals into a cohesive, synchronized team.

Every dancer selected for the team is required to attend all competition days. Some dancers may be designated as alternates due to routine size limitations; however, alternates are equally valued and play an essential role in team success.

As a performance-based team, every individual's decisions directly impact the group. Preparation for competition requires months of dedicated practice. Unlike some sports, there is not a pool of interchangeable substitutes ready to step in without preparation. Responsibility, accountability, and teamwork are essential.

There is no size cap on the team. Students who can manage the time and financial commitment are encouraged to participate, even if they are involved in other activities.

### **Coaching Staff**

#### **Rodney Anderson**

Coach Rodney Anderson enters his 21st year coaching varsity dance, including 17 years at Ashwaubenon and 4 years at Waupaca. Over his career, he has choreographed 16 Varsity State Championship-winning routines (7 Pom, 6 Kick, 3 Jazz). Nine of these were with Ashwaubenon, four with Waupaca, and three with Franklin He has qualified all 20 of his varsity teams for the WACPC State Dance Competition since 2006. He served as a WACPC At-Large Board Member in 2024–2025. In 2024, he was recognized as a WACPC Dance Coach of the Year with Andrew Meinel.

#### **Andrew Meinel**

Coach Andrew Meinel enters his 17th year with the Jaguaress Dance Team. In addition to assisting at practices and competitions, he coordinates fundraising efforts, music editing, formation design, uniform planning, and the Ashwaubenon Dance Invitational. He previously served as the WACPC District 3 Representative and was also recognized as a 2024 WACPC Dance Coach of the Year with Rodney Anderson.

#### **Ashley Shimanek**

Ashley Shimanek serves as assistant coach. She helped establish the middle school dance program within the Ashwaubenon School District and coaches the Parkview Middle School Dance Team. A former Jaguaress dancer, she also competed as a member of the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay Dance Team.

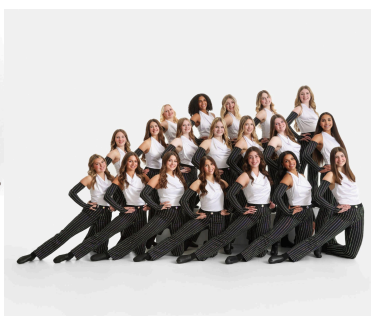
### **Looking Ahead**

## WHAT TO EXPECT:

Candidates will learn three short routines during tryout week—a pom, kick, and jazz routine (each approximately 45–60 seconds)—and will perform in small groups for a panel of judges consisting of the Ashwaubenon Jaguaress Dance Team coaches and other award-winning Wisconsin dance coaches. Dancers will be evaluated on the routines as well as technical skills including right and left splits, toe touches, and pirouettes, which will be taught and reviewed during pre-tryout practices and throughout tryout week. There is also a special skills portion of the score sheet (A-turns, tumbling, jump combinations, etc.), and all candidates should plan to showcase at least one additional skill, as any skill is better than none and will be added to the overall score. For returning dancers, previous years' attitude, performance, effort, leadership, teamwork, and overall commitment to the program will also be taken into consideration when final team decisions are made.

## TRYOUT WEEK ATTENDANCE:

Tryout Week practice attendance is mandatory unless excused by a coach. Do not relay absences through a friend—if you will be missing, you must contact the coaches directly by email at [ameinel@ashwaubenonk12.org](mailto:ameinel@ashwaubenonk12.org) or [rodneyanderson.rja@gmail.com](mailto:rodneyanderson.rja@gmail.com) . This is your responsibility. Work is not considered an excuse, so please plan and schedule accordingly in advance.

\*\*\*\*If you have a spring sports commitment, that commitment should remain your first priority. Do not jeopardize that team's practices or games to attend dance tryout practices, as you must honor the commitment you have already made. If you must miss any portion of tryout week, it will be your responsibility to find someone to teach you the missed choreography outside of scheduled practice time.

## WHAT TO WEAR/BRING:

**Tryout Practices/Pre-Tryout Practices:** Black athletic clothing, dance shoes are preferred but socks are acceptable if you do not have any. No Jewelry please! Bring a water bottle and all paperwork that is due by the deadlines given in this tryout packet.

**Tryout Day:** A pair of black, fitted shorts or leggings and a black shirt with ***NO PRINT*** on it. Shirts should be tucked in (or fitted) and stomachs should NOT be visible. Please wear a sports bra under your shirt. Hair should be pulled back and makeup should be applied on this day. **If you wear glasses, you will need to put in contacts or dance without your glasses.** It is our job to make you look as similar as possible. Glasses will not be allowed during practices, performances or competitions.

## JUDGING CRITERIA:

The following criteria will be considered during judging:

1. **Dance Ability and Rhythm-** able to complete steps, in control and on beat.
2. **Knowledge of Routine-** Are you able to perform it confidently with good knowledge?
3. **Precision and Form-** sharp movements, full extensions.
4. **Jumps-** good height, pointed toes, straight legs.
5. **Turns-** solid "landing", pulled up through torso area, head spots.
6. **Smile and Audience Appeal-** Do you appear to be having fun?

Successful completion of your right and left splits and adequate high kicks are **mandatory** for placement on the team. Judges will be looking for kicks that are *at least* shoulder level, with a straight back and supporting leg, head up, and toes pointed. Splits should be flat to the ground, with a straight upper body and pointed toes.

# ELIGIBILITY:

Tryouts are open to any student who will be attending Ashwaubenon High School during the upcoming school year. **A grade point average of 1.5 will be required for placement on the team.** (This is a school policy that we must abide by)

# TRYOUT FORMS:

A personal questionnaire and tryout contact information sheet is included with your application. Also included are your teacher evaluation forms, which need to be signed off on by your parents before handing them to each of your teachers. This allows the teacher to be able to release your grade. You can make copies of these forms if needed, by going to [www.ashwaubenondanceteam.com](http://www.ashwaubenondanceteam.com) and accessing the "Tryouts" page.

It is your responsibility to submit the teacher evaluation forms to each of your teachers for their completion. **YOU** are responsible for ensuring that your teacher has completed these forms. **You must have a completed form from each of your 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter teachers.** Please do this early so that your teacher has enough time to fill them out and return them by the deadline.

All forms are due no later than **Tuesday, March 10<sup>th</sup>**. Inability to get these forms in on time will reflect poorly on your ability to be a successful member on our team. Please come talk to us if you are having issues with a particular teacher that will not complete the evaluation form. Please consider this, and be organized and neat as you prepare the forms. These are the characteristics we will be looking for when selecting the team.

# ATTENDANCE EXPECTATIONS:

If you are selected as an Ashwaubenon Jaguaress Dancer, you should be aware that ALL PRACTICES, GAME PERFORMANCES and COMPETITIONS are **MANDATORY**, they are NOT optional.

You are expected to be in attendance at **every** practice, for the **entire** practice time and at each scheduled competition/performance. Involvement in any activity that would cause a conflict, be it a job, athletics, clubs or other school activities, will make it impossible for you to be a member of the Ashwaubenon Jaguaress Dance Team. Because this is a performance based team activity, any absence makes it difficult for everyone else; therefore it is absolutely essential that this rule be enforced.

# MANDATORY 1ST PARENT MEETING:

If you make the Ashwaubenon Jaguaress Dance Team there will be a **MANDATORY** parent meeting on **Monday March 23rd from 6:00pm-8:00pm in the AHS Library**. At least **one parent/guardian** must attend this meeting with you. At this meeting we will be going over all expectations for the year and the cost to be a part of the dance team. You and your parents need to decide by the end of the parent meeting if you accept the position on the team or not. If you decide you are going to accept the position on the team we will be collecting the money for the **New Dancer Supplies** at this meeting.

We will also be collecting the security deposit checks. (Listed on the payment page) These checks **WILL NOT** be cashed unless you do not meet the requirements and expectations of the Uniform Rental/Raffle Ticket Fundraiser or if a dancer **QUITS** the dance team to help pay for the cost of purchasing uniforms/non-refundable competition fees for the team. The check will be returned to you to dispose of upon the completion of the season if you meet the requirements/expectations. There will also be **contracts** that will need to be signed for our main two fundraisers on the minimum amount of slots required by each family and the penalty fees for those that do not come up with the required amount of volunteers. (Details are included on the Estimated Cost Page)

Being selected as an Ashwaubenon Jaguaress Dancer is an honor and a privilege that only a few girls will experience throughout their time in high school. There are many who would like to be selected, who are willing to give the time and effort necessary. **If you are not able to meet these requirements, please do not try out.** Responsibility to the team and its members will be of the highest priority.

We will be available during any of the tryout days for any questions you might have. If you decide to try out, please complete the attached forms and return them by **Tuesday, March 10<sup>th</sup>** at the tryout practice that night from **6:00pm-8:30pm** in the **Ashwaubenon High School Small Gym**. ### Total Cost For Dancers:

Estimated Cost - **\$1860.00**

### Payments:

A payment of \$200 will need to be made into the dancers account each month for 10 Months (March - January). As the year goes on this total will be re-evaluated with each individual dancer's account on if less payments need to be made. If the total of payments exceed a dancer's total expenses, the additional dollar amount in an account can be used for State Dinner and Banquet Expenses for Parents and Family members attending those events or be carried over to the next dance season for returning members.

### Failure to Meet \$200 Payments:

If a payment is not received within two weeks after the due date the dancers will need to sit all performances until payment has been made.

### Main Fundraising Events:

If the minimum number of volunteer slots are not fulfilled for our two main fundraisers (Resch Concessions and/or the Ashwaubenon Dance Invitational), the dancer will NOT be eligible to attend the next Nationals competition and may be at risk of being removed from routines.

### Security Deposit Checks:

- Jazz Uniform - \$300.00** (Pay \$300.00 up front) --- **OR** --- **Raffle Ticket Fundraiser** (Sell \$300.00 worth in tickets)
- Pom Uniform - To Be Determined** (If a dancer quits the team - cashed for non-refundable uniforms)
- Kick Uniform - To Be Determined** (If a dancer quits the team - cashed for non-refundable uniforms)
- Nationals Flight - To Be Determined** (If a dancer quits the team - cashed for non-refundable plane tickets costs)

# Team Expectations

## ASHWAUBENON JAGUARESS DANCE TEAM 2025–2026

As a member of the 2026–2027 AHS Dance Team, I agree to follow the guidelines and expectations outlined below.

### Attendance & Punctuality

- Practice will begin promptly at the scheduled start time. Dancers are expected to arrive 5–10 minutes early to change into jazz shoes and appropriate practice attire and be fully prepared to begin.
- A dancer must be enrolled in 3rd/4th Hour Dance in order to attend practice.

### Excused Absences

- All known conflicts must be communicated to a coach at least 48 hours in advance.
  - Notification does not automatically mean the absence will be excused. Coaches will determine excused/unexcused status.
- Parental contact (text/email/phone call) is required to excuse a dancer.
- Dancers are allowed:
  - 2 excused absences during summer
  - 2 excused absences during the school year
  - One pre-approved summer family vacation or school trip listed on the Summer Conflict Schedule will not count toward these totals.
- Missed portions of practice will count as:
  - .25 = 1–25%
  - .5 = 25–50%
  - .75 = 50–75%
  - 1.0 = 75–100%
- No dancer will be excused:
  - The day of a performance
  - The practice prior to a competition
  - During the month of January through State Weekend (first weekend in February)
- The only exception to the above policies is a death in the family.
- Excessive absences beyond allotted excused days may result in sitting out a football/basketball game and may progress to competitions if absences become habitual.
- Any unexcused absence will result in sitting the next performance.

### Illness & Injury Policy

- Parental contact is required for illness, and the illness must be specified.
- If a dancer is not contagious and can attend, they are expected to be present and follow along (no cell phone use).
- If unable to attend due to illness, a doctor's note is required with:
  - Return-to-dance timeline
  - Whether the dancer may attend to observe
- A Google Meet option may be provided for viewing practice from home.
- For injuries:
  - One "take it easy" day is allowed with parent notification.
  - After one day, a doctor's note with treatment plan and timeline is required.
  - Dancers sitting out may not use phones or do homework and must remain engaged in practice.

### Practice Expectations

- No cell phones or eating during practice or breaks unless permitted.
- Arrive prepared with:
  - Water bottle / Proper attire / Jazz shoes / Proper nutrition beforehand
- Maintain a positive attitude.
- Remain silent/quiet unless instructed otherwise.
- Be fully prepared for games and competitions — no second chances for forgotten items.

### Conduct & Character

- Team members will not attend gatherings involving smoking, vaping, alcohol, or illegal substances. Violations will result in suspension.
- Dance team members are ambassadors of Ashwaubenon High School.
- Conduct expectations include:
  - Positive attitude / Respectful behavior / Appropriate school conduct
- I will use social media responsibly, refraining from posting negative comments, videos, or photos about the team, dancers, dance families, coaches, or other teams, and will not share any inappropriate or disrespectful content about teammates, opponents.

## Academic Requirement

- Dancers must maintain a 1.5 cumulative GPA.
- Random grade checks may occur.

## Commitment & Responsibility

- Dancers are trying out by their own choice — not due to parental pressure.
- Dancers commit to finishing the season if selected.
- Quitting mid-season negatively impacts the entire team.
- Dancers who do not receive passing tryout scores may not try out again.
- If a dancer quits after the initial parent meeting:
  - Security deposits will not be refunded.
  - Personal account SCRIP balances will be forfeited.
  - Funds help cover non-refundable competition fees, uniforms (\$500–\$700+), and travel expenses.

## Time Commitment Agreement

- I will attend as many practices as possible and notify coaches in advance if I am unable to attend.
- I will make the Dance Team my primary extracurricular focus outside of school responsibilities.
- I will avoid participating in activities or sports that regularly conflict with the dance team schedule, including but not limited to:
  - Volleyball, Cross Country, Tennis, Swimming, Golf, Basketball, Hockey, Cheerleading, recreational dance teaching programs or any other activity that interferes with practices or performances.
- I will recognize that participation in other extracurriculars such as DECA, DI, Encore, High School Musical, studio dance, gymnastics, jobs, or exchange programs may result in missed practices or performances. I understand that excessive absences may result in removal from one or more routines or from the team entirely, with no refund of fees, payments, or deposits.
- I will do everything in my capabilities to be present at all practices, performances, and competitions for the upcoming season.

## Parent Agreement

As a parent/guardian:

- I am not forcing my child to try out.
- I will support the coaches and uphold all school and team policies.
- I will not use dance attendance as punishment or reward.
- I will not remove my child from practice for GPA standards higher than school athletic policy.
- I will monitor my child's social media and refrain from negative posts about the program.
- I will communicate respectfully with other parents, keeping all interactions positive and focused on supporting the team.
- I will use social media responsibly, refraining from posting negative comments, videos, or photos about the team, dancers, dance families, coaches, or other teams, and will not share any inappropriate or disrespectful content about teammates, opponents.
- I will not post uniform photos, routines, or performances without coach approval.
- I will follow all safety and driving laws when transporting dancers.
- I understand financial responsibilities, including:
  - \$200 monthly payments until balance is paid
  - Sitting out performances if payments are not made
  - No tryouts if previous balances are unpaid
- I understand volunteer requirements for fundraisers (Resch Concessions and Ashwaubenon Dance Invitational).
- I understand that security deposits for National Competition years may be cashed if travel expenses are non-refundable.
- I accept full (or equal split) financial responsibility for all dues and penalties.
