The Hopewell-Loudon Local School District is located in west central Seneca County. It is mostly rural, encompassing approximately 66 square miles between Fostoria and Tiffin. The district constructed a new Pre-K to 12 building in 2013 and it is located on the edge of Bascom. Of our 790 enrolled students, approximately 32% are open-enrolled from other districts.

What we offer:

- Career Technical Education through Vanguard Sentinel Career & Technology Center.
- 7 College Credit Plus (CCP) certified teachers offering in-house CCP courses, or students may choose to take CCP courses off-campus or online.
- Chieftain Academy- an online curriculum with a teacher on staff in charge of monitoring attendance, progress, and aiding in the delivery of instruction.
- Traditional all-day Preschool that meets two times per week.
