

BUSINESS AND NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

Tuition Fees

The School Board will charge tuition fees for certain nonresident students allowed to enroll in the School Division.

A. Nonresident, Nonemployee's Student Tuition

The Superintendent shall recommend to the School Board the tuition fees to be charged **for** nonresident, nonemployees' students based on the per capita cost. The School Board shall then fix and determine the amount of tuition fees to be charged. No tuition charges fixed by the School Board shall exceed the total per capita cost of education, exclusive of capital outlay and debt service, for elementary or secondary pupils and the actual, additional costs of special education or gifted and talented program provided **to** the pupil.

B. Nonresident, Employees' Students

Non-resident full-time VBCPS employees, ~~to include SECEP employees~~, working in Virginia Beach City Public Schools, will be allowed to enroll their child(ren) tuition free. Enrollment will be contingent on meeting requirements outlined in Regulation 5-10.1 and Policy 5-14.

1. If a non-resident full-time VBCPS employee is no longer employed with VBCPS or is no longer a full-time employee for VBCPS, a non-resident student of such employee may be allowed to continue enrollment in VBCPS without tuition through the end of the current nine-week period.
2. At the school principal's sole discretion, the student may remain enrolled with VBCPS through the end of the school year. However, tuition must be paid for the remainder of the school year or any portion thereof that the student attends. Continued enrollment is conditioned on good behavior, regular good-attendance, good academic progress, the provision of transportation by the student's family, and payment of tuition.
3. Students allowed to continue enrollment in VBCPS after their non-resident parent ceases employment will not be eligible to continue in VBCPS once their extension is concluded unless the student meets another category under Regulation 5-10.1.

C. Additional fees may be charged depending upon the services required.
