## Special Education Child Find

### Community Partnership

Each year, the Governor Wentworth Regional School District provides notice to our community area agencies of our federal and state Child Find responsibility. Our mission is to locate, evaluate, and identify children ages 2.5 through 21, inclusive, who are suspected to be children with an educational disability within the geographic boundaries of our school district.

### Do you have concerns about a child's development or learning?

If you suspect that a child has an educational disability, please take the first step by contacting the school in the town where the child resides.

### How to make a Referral

**Step 1:** Contact the school in the town where the child resides directly.

**Step 2:** Ask to speak with the Principal or the Diagnostic Prescriptive Teacher (DPT) regarding a Special Education Referral.
