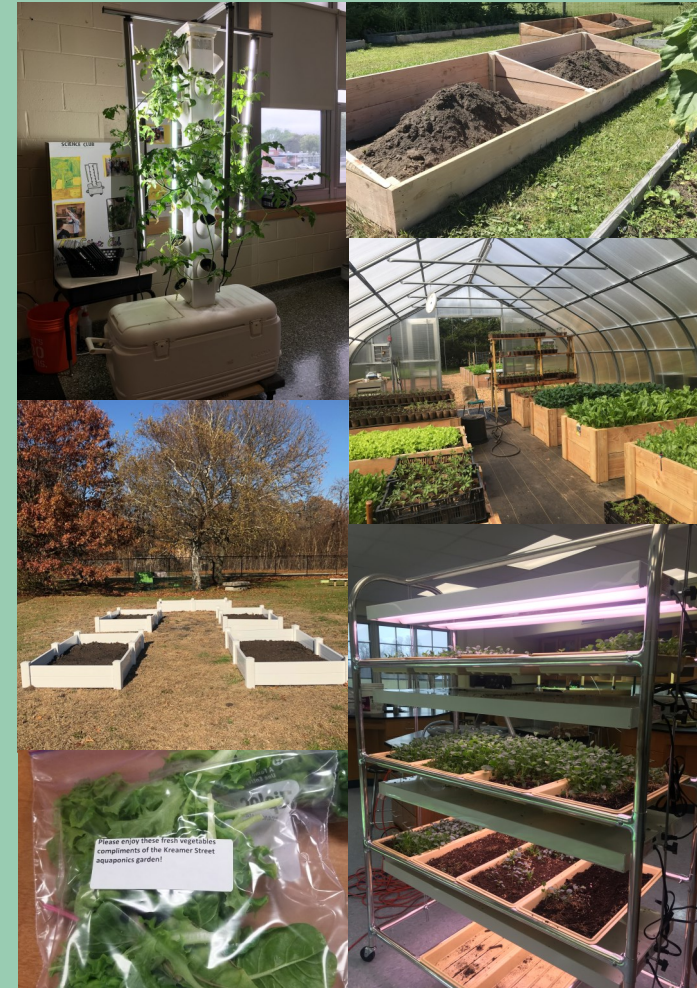

## Who?

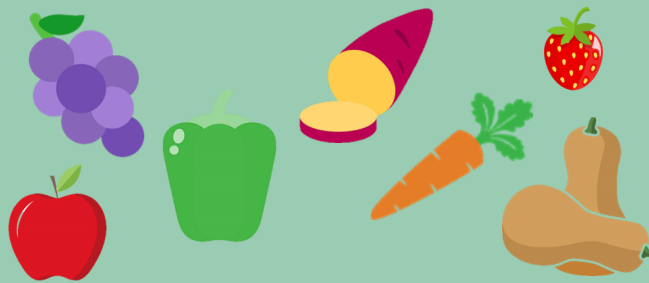
Since 2017, Suffolk County Soil & Water Conservation District has administered this Grant Program to develop, sustain, and expand agricultural education programs in Suffolk County public K-12 schools.

## Why?

The goal of this program is to increase the awareness and understanding of local agricultural production in Suffolk County by developing students' skills in obtaining healthy, fresh, and local foods.

## How much?

This year, AG in the Classroom has a total of **\$100,000** to award to successful applicants. Our highest amount yet! Proposed project budgets must range from \$3,000 - \$50,000.



## PROJECT IDEAS

These include, but are not limited to:

### Indoor Settings

- Grow systems (lights, tables, ect.)
- Hydroponics
- Aquaculture
- Plant tissue cultures
- Food Production

### Outdoor Settings

- Greenhouses
- Compost Systems
- Pollinator Habitat
- Livestock (poultry, insects, ect.)
- Agroforestry
- Agriculture Education Field Trips



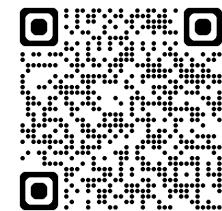

Step 2: Create an application you and your school support and are able to implement (Submissions must follow format and guidance in the RFP)

Step 3: Submit your application via email no later than **February 28, 2026.**

Step 4: Wait for awards to be announced by the end of **April 2026.**
