### ➡ SECTION 4: REGISTER ONLINE IN STUDENTVUE

Check for Accuracy:

  - 2 courses = 1 Credit
  - A full year class counts as 2 courses = 1 Credit
    - Example: Ch. English 8 should have 2 entries: ENG850A & ENG850B
2. Alternate elective requests should have 5 entries.
3. **Once entered, course requests will automatically be saved.**
