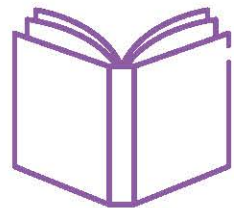


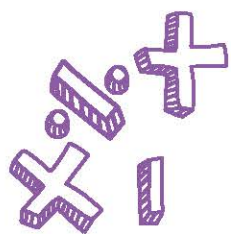

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS ([LINK TO PARENT GUIDE](#))

- Understand print and sounds – Know that print has meaning, follow text, name letters, and match them to sounds.
- Read simple texts – Use letter sounds and sight words to read and retell short stories and facts.
- Understand what's read – Ask and answer questions, retell key details, and explain how pictures help meaning.
- Share ideas in writing and drawing – Use pictures, words, and simple sentences to tell stories or share information.
- Listen and speak clearly – Take turns, answer questions, and share ideas in complete sentences.
- Build and use vocabulary – Learn and use new words to describe and explain ideas.
- Use literacy across subjects – Read, write, and talk to learn and share in all areas.
- Grow as independent learners – Set goals, keep trying, and practice reading and writing.



MATHEMATICS ([LINK TO PARENT GUIDE](#))

- Count forward to 100 by ones and tens, noticing patterns in the numbers.
- Recognize, read, and write numbers from 0 to 20.
- Count objects or pictures to determine “how many” up to 20.
- Compare two numbers between 1 and 10 using written numerals.
- Break apart and combine numbers from 11 to 19 into tens and ones.
- Examine and compare 2D and 3D shapes, describing their parts, similarities, and differences.
- Solve simple addition and subtraction word problems within 10.
- Add and subtract numbers within 5 quickly and accurately.
