VII. Update: Financial Forecast

Mrs. Johnson shared an update of the financial forecast. The only change in forecasted revenue was an increase to Income Tax revenue reflecting FY26 current collection. State funding and property tax revenue were discussed in light of state funding limitations and recent property tax legislation. With regard to expenditures, forecasted personnel services were increased as staffing considerations continue for the 26-27 school year. Capital Outlay was also increased to account for significant inflationary pressure on the cost of technology items. The District will continue to monitor 25-26 revenue and expenditures compared to forecast and may revisit adoption of an updated forecast in May or June.

VIII. Update: Artificial Intelligence

Mr. Weber presented an update on Artificial Intelligence work in the District. He reviewed the recommendations from the 23-24 CAC study, the 24-25 formation of the AI Guidance Document and the focus on professional development during the 25-26 school year. Next steps include expanding and developing the District AI Team, further refinement of the AI policy aligned with legislation and practice, development of a K-12 AI literacy framework by grade bands, connection of AI learning to Digital Citizenship curriculum, deployment of baseline PD for staff, parent information sessions and ongoing review of ethical use guidelines.

IX. 020-26 Executive Session

Mr. Thomas moved to have the Board of Education enter into Executive Session for specialized details of security arrangements where disclosure of the information to be discussed in Executive Session might reveal information that could be used to commit, or avoid prosecution for, a violation of the law by division (G)(6) of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. Mr. Lee seconded the motion.
