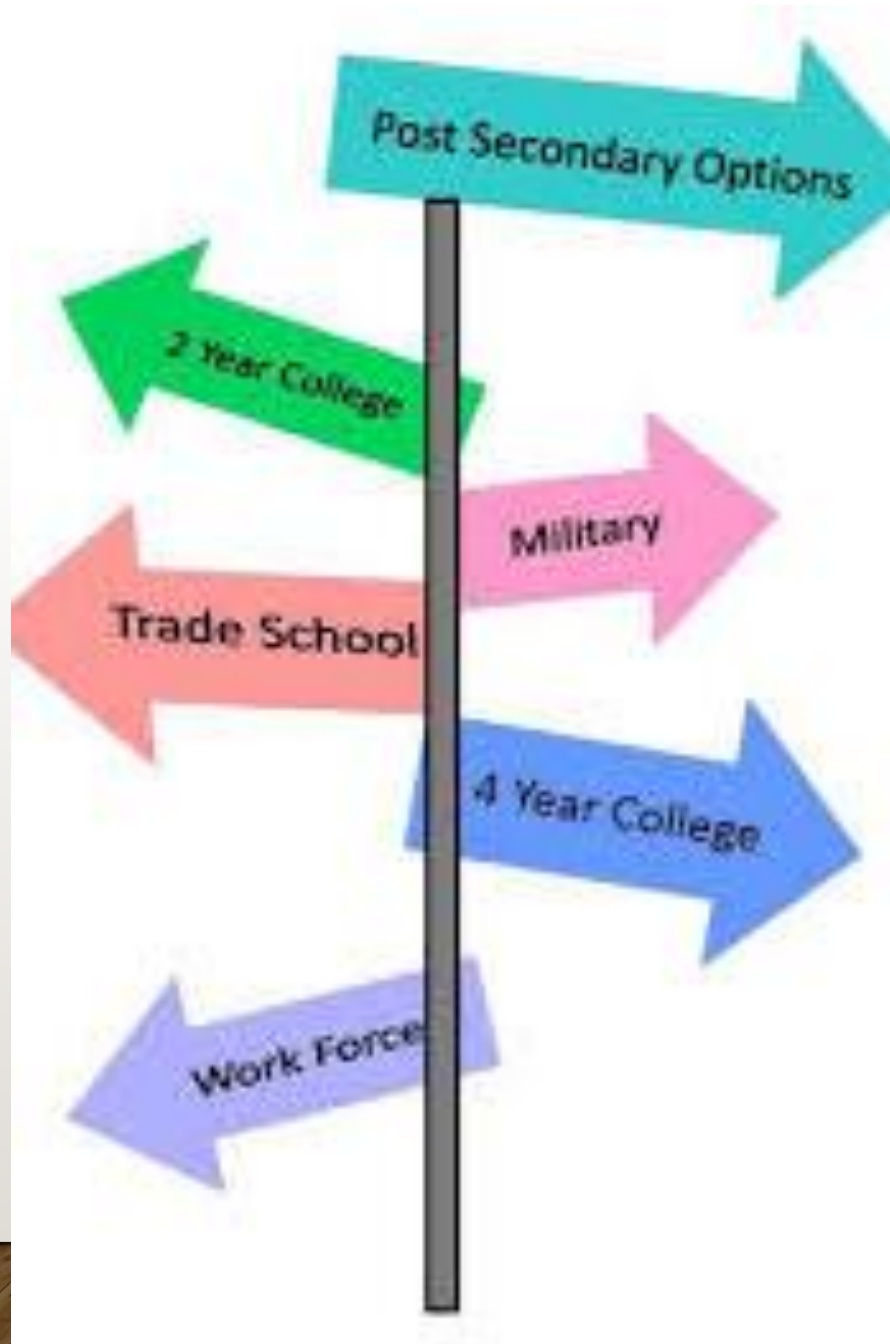


GOAL:

SCHEDULING TIMELINE

- February 25
 - 8th grade meeting during school
 - Parent Scheduling Information Night: 6:00pm at the High School Auditorium
- February 26-March 10
 - Students enter requests into PowerSchool
- March and April
 - HS Counselors meet with all High School and 8th grade students to finalize requests
- End of April
 - Verification letters mailed home to parents

PA STATE PATHWAYS TO GRADUATION

- Keystone Proficiency – score proficient or advanced on all 3 keystones
- Keystone Composite – scores of all 3 Keystones add to or exceed a cut score
- CTE Concentrator Pathway – Completing a TCHS program
- Alternative Assessment Pathway – scoring a certain score on other tests or acceptance into a 4 year college with a specific degree program
- Evidence-Based Pathway – acceptance into a less than 4 year college and other pieces of evidence

9 th Grade to 10 th Grade	6.0 credits
10 th Grade to 11 th Grade	12.0 credits
11 th Grade to 12 th Grade	18.5 credits
12 th Grade to Graduation	25.5 credits

*Students will stay with the grade level homeroom regardless of credits earned. Please be aware of graduation requirements and stay on track!

REQUIRED CLASSES FOR 9TH GRADE: (CURRENT 8TH GRADERS)

- Core classes – teacher recommendation (4.0 credits)
 - English, Math, Science, and Social Studies
- Health (0.5 credits)
- Lifetime Fitness OR Wellness Walking (0.5 credits)
- TCB(Taking Care of Business) and Seminar (0.5 credits)
 - *Gifted Seminar 9 or Transitions I also meet this requirement*
- Elective choices to complete 8.0 credits

REQUIRED CLASSES FOR 10TH GRADE: (CURRENT 9TH GRADERS)

- Core classes – teacher recommendation (4.0 credits)
 - English, Math, Science, Social Studies
- Additional PE course recommended (0.5 credits)
 - (Health and Lifetime Fitness required if not taken in 9th grade)
- Elective Choices to complete 8.0 credits

REQUIRED CLASSES FOR 11TH GRADE: (CURRENT 10TH GRADERS)

- Core classes – teacher recommendation (4.0 credits)
 - English, Math, Science, Social Studies
- Financial Fitness (0.5 credits)
- Elective Choices to complete 8.0 credits

REQUIRED CLASSES FOR 12TH GRADE: (CURRENT 11TH GRADERS)

- Core classes – teacher recommendation (3.0 credits)
 - English, Math, Science
- Elective credits to complete 8.0 credits
