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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 10% increase in students at mid or above grade level and 5% decrease in students at 2 or more grade levels below, 12% have met stretch goal in math.</li> <li>● Attendance rate has improved from last year.</li> <li>● Behavior trends have improved based on fewer minor referrals, major incidents, OSS, and expulsions.</li> <li>● Budget update – due to several challenges outside of FCS’s control, the development of 26-27 budget will be a challenging process. Our expected enrollment is higher than current which should put us in a better position to not lose a teacher. We will likely learn additional CTAE program dollars.</li> </ul>
