Color Run Frequently Asked Questions (Middle School and Upper School)

- **Will the color wash off skin and hair?**
Yes! Shake off excess powder while dry. Soap and water will remove the rest.
- **What if it gets in our eyes?**
The color is non-toxic. Flush eyes with water if needed. Sunglasses are recommended.
- **What should students wear?**
TRA-approved spirit wear shirts. Homecoming dress code applies. Please bring a change of clothes.
- **Are the colors safe?**
Yes. The powder is made from corn starch and natural dyes, free of harsh chemicals or heavy metals.
- **Can students inhale or eat the color?**
Inhaling large amounts is not recommended; bandanas may be worn. Eating the color is discouraged, but small accidental ingestion is harmless.
- **How is the color dispensed?**
There will be **four color stations** along the course. The **grade that raises the most funds** will earn an extra color toss at the start of the race.
- **Want to keep your colored shirt?**
Soak it in vinegar, air dry, and iron before washing to set the color.
