

SPECIAL EDUCATION CENTERS

BLOOMFIELD EDUCATION CENTER (BEC) **Bloomfield, NY**

Newly opened in 2025, BEC introduces a specialized 6:1:1 program for students in grades K–2, extending the services of the Midlakes Education Center. Designed to support students on the autism spectrum, this full-day program emphasizes social, behavioral, and communication skill development through highly individualized instruction in a nurturing environment.

FINGER LAKES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (FLES) **Gorham, NY**

FLES serves students in grades 3–5 with a wide range of learning needs, including autism, through a full-day program focused on social, emotional, and academic growth. Students receive individualized supports in pragmatic language, social awareness, academics, and behavior management. Comprehensive therapies (including occupational, physical, speech and language, and music therapy) are complemented by services from school psychologists, counselors, and social workers. Sensory rooms and structured movement breaks further support regulation and engagement, helping students thrive in and beyond the classroom.

FINGER LAKES SECONDARY SCHOOL (FLSS) **Rushville, NY**

FLSS supports students in grades 6–12 through academic programming that builds social skills, confidence, and independence. The program includes individual and group counseling, day treatment services, NYS Regents preparation, and college and career exploration.

MIDLAKES EDUCATION CENTER (MEC) **Clifton Springs, NY**

MEC serves students in grades K–12 and provides a highly supportive learning environment focused on strengthening communication, social, and behavioral skills. Students benefit from a multidisciplinary approach that includes occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech and language services, clinical support, music therapy, physical education, and assistive technology.

FINGER LAKES TECH & CAREER CENTER (FLTCC) **Stanley, NY**

- **Focus:** Programs in agriculture and animal sciences, computer and communications, construction and fabrication, New Visions Health, the transportation industry, and the service industry.
- FLTCC serves students in grades 11 & 12 and is dedicated to providing high quality, comprehensive technical and career programs to students living primarily in Ontario, Seneca, and Yates counties.

WAYNE TECH & CAREER CENTER (WTCC) **Williamson, NY**

- **Focus:** Programs in agriculture and animal sciences, computer and communications, construction and fabrication, New Visions Health, the transportation industry, and the service industry.
- WTCC serves students in grades 11 & 12, and is dedicated to providing state-of-the-art, hands-on educational programs to students living primarily in Wayne County.

P-TECH HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM

- **Focus:** College and career readiness utilizing STEM-based programs allowing students to earn both a high school diploma and a no-cost, two-year postsecondary degree in partnership with Finger Lakes Community College.
- P-TECH serves students in grades 9–14 and is focused on creating pathways between education and in-demand, high-tech careers in a learning environment equipped with the tools necessary for success.

SPECIAL EDUCATION CENTERS

NEWARK EDUCATION CENTER (NEC) & CAREER CREATIONS Newark, NY

NEC serves students in grades K–12 through a student-centered, collaborative approach focused on communication, physical mobility, functional skills development, and therapeutic crisis intervention. The program removes barriers and creates opportunities so every student can experience success in a supportive learning environment.

Career Creations, an extension of NEC, serves students in grades 10–12+ with tailored pathways for diverse needs. Programs include Functional Skills Development (FSD) for self-care, communication, and pre-vocational skills; Communication and Physical Mobility Development (CPMD) for academic and mobility growth; and Academic, Communication, and Career Development (ACCD) for strengthening academic, social, and career readiness skills.

RED JACKET EDUCATION CENTER (RJEC) Shortsville, NY

RJEC serves students in grades K–6 and provides a safe, positive learning environment grounded in personalized instruction and social skill development. Academic programming includes leveled literacy using the Really Great Reading program, i-Ready, IXL Math, and Everyday Math.

WAYNE EDUCATION CENTER (WEC) Williamson, NY

WEC serves students in grades 7–12 through programming that blends positive behavioral interventions, therapeutic crisis intervention, NYS Regents preparation, and school-to-career opportunities. Students develop workforce readiness through community job sites and structured skill-building activities that support high school completion and successful post-secondary transitions.
