**Middle & High School Students:** Specialized transportation if listed in the IEP.



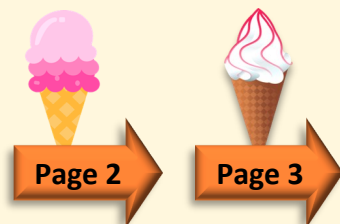
