# FALL 2026 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION FEBRUARY 2 - MAY 15

Children must be age 5 by July 31, 2026 to attend school in the fall.

Kindergarten Registration is a three-step process:

## STEP 1: PRE-REGISTER ONLINE

Complete the pre-registration form at [www.fargo.k12.nd.us/registration](http://www.fargo.k12.nd.us/registration).

After office staff review and approve your pre-registration, a confirmation email with instructions to create the PowerSchool account will be sent.

## STEP 2: POWERSCHOOL REGISTRATION FORMS

Create a Parent PowerSchool Account and complete the registration forms.

## STEP 3: SUBMIT REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Upload or bring the following documents to your child's school:

- Child's Certified Birth Certificate
- Parent Identity (driver's license)
- Child's Immunization Record (with 5-year shots)
- Proof of Address (lease/mortgage statement or two documents that include parent/guardian name and current address, such as a utility bill and paystub)



For assistance, please contact your child's school to schedule an appointment to complete in-person.



A second round of registration will reopen in July with a different process.

### **FPS now offers tickets and passes online with GoFan Digital Ticketing**

Fargo Public Schools now offers high school sports fans the ability to purchase tickets and season passes online with GoFan Digital Ticketing! To purchase tickets or season passes, **visit [gofan.co](http://gofan.co)** or use the **GoFan Mobile App**, and search for your event.

Prior to arriving at the gate, have the ticket/pass open and ready on your mobile device by accessing your confirmation email or viewing the ticket in the mobile app. Show the ticket/pass to the gate workers and they will validate your ticket. You **MUST** use your mobile device, tickets cannot be printed for admission at the gate. Cash will still be taken at the gate for daily admission, but fans are encouraged to use GoFan for ease.
