### Flexible Learning Day – Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2026

We are excited to announce that we will once again be holding a Flexible Learning Day for all pupils in Year 7-13 on **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March**. This is a brilliant opportunity for our students to engage in further learning opportunities and to gain valuable experience in a range of personal development activities.

Please read below for further information regarding the structure of the day for each individual year group.

**Year 7 pupils will be involved in an Equality & Diversity Day.** This will include a range of lessons focused on British Heroes, the Equality Act and British Values. There will also be sessions on relative poverty and the environment and sustainability. Students will also be involved in some practical tasks on the day. *Students should arrive to school on Wednesday 11th in their school PE kit.*

**Year 8 pupils will take part in a Careers Day.** This day will involve sessions learning about a range of different jobs, careers and professions relating to different subject areas. It will try to get students thinking about their future post Kineton School and the vast array of opportunities available to them. Students will learn about jobs within different sectors of industry including Sport, Science, the Arts and Humanities. *Students should arrive on Wednesday 11th in their school PE kit.*

**Year 9 are taking part in a Health Day.** This involves a practical session learning about basic CPR and First Aid, as well as taking part in a fun practical fitness lesson. Students will also be involved in sessions focussing on how to maintain both positive physical and mental health. They will also have sessions on the effects of social media and alcohol and vaping. *Students should arrive to school on Wednesday 11th in their school PE kit.*

**Year 10 pupils will be involved in an Enterprise Day.** This day will involve pupils working in small groups to take part in an Enterprise Challenge ran by the business department. It will help to develop pupils' teamwork, creativity and entrepreneurial skills. There will also be a session for students delivered by an external company looking at oracy, communication and teamwork skills.

**Year 11 pupils are learning about a range of Life Skills.** This will allow Year 11 pupils to get a better understanding of life after school. There will be a variety of sessions delivered by a variety of external guest speakers including lessons on relationships and sex education, road safety, post-16 options and pathways, and a session by the Police looking at misogyny and violence against women and girls. There will also be a session delivered on revision techniques and exam stress.

**Year 12's will be taking part in a Careers Day.** This will involve learning about Apprenticeships, Post-18 Higher Education, the World of Work and Gap Year Options. Activities will include a World of Work Decisions Game designed by EKFB Engineering Ltd, a Worcester University presentation on getting the most out of the UCAS Discovery careers day on the 19th March, learning about and researching apprenticeships, and a session on how to plan a gap year. We end the day with a presentation from Oxford Brookes University on 'How to Choose a Course and a University'.

**Year 13 pupils will be preparing for life after A Levels.** This will include working with the University of Warwick on budgeting and managing their money, receiving CPR and first aid training from an external provider, learning how to manage their mental health, and a session on how to keep themselves safe as they move away from home and live independently. Students will also have time allocated for silent revision.

**We are asking for parental support to ensure that all pupils in Year 7, 8 and 9 come to school in their full School PE kit on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March.** This is to allow students to take part fully in any practical sessions that have been planned for them during the day.

**Pupils in Year 10, 11, 12 and 13 are to arrive at school in their full school uniform as normal.** This is to ensure that they look smart and presentable for their careers-based sessions.
