March 2nd through March 6th is Exceptional Children's Week, where we will be Celebrating Minds of All Kinds!

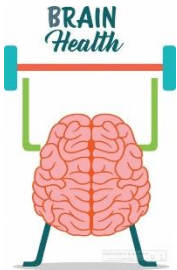
