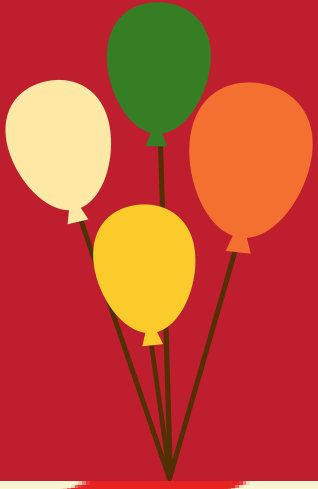

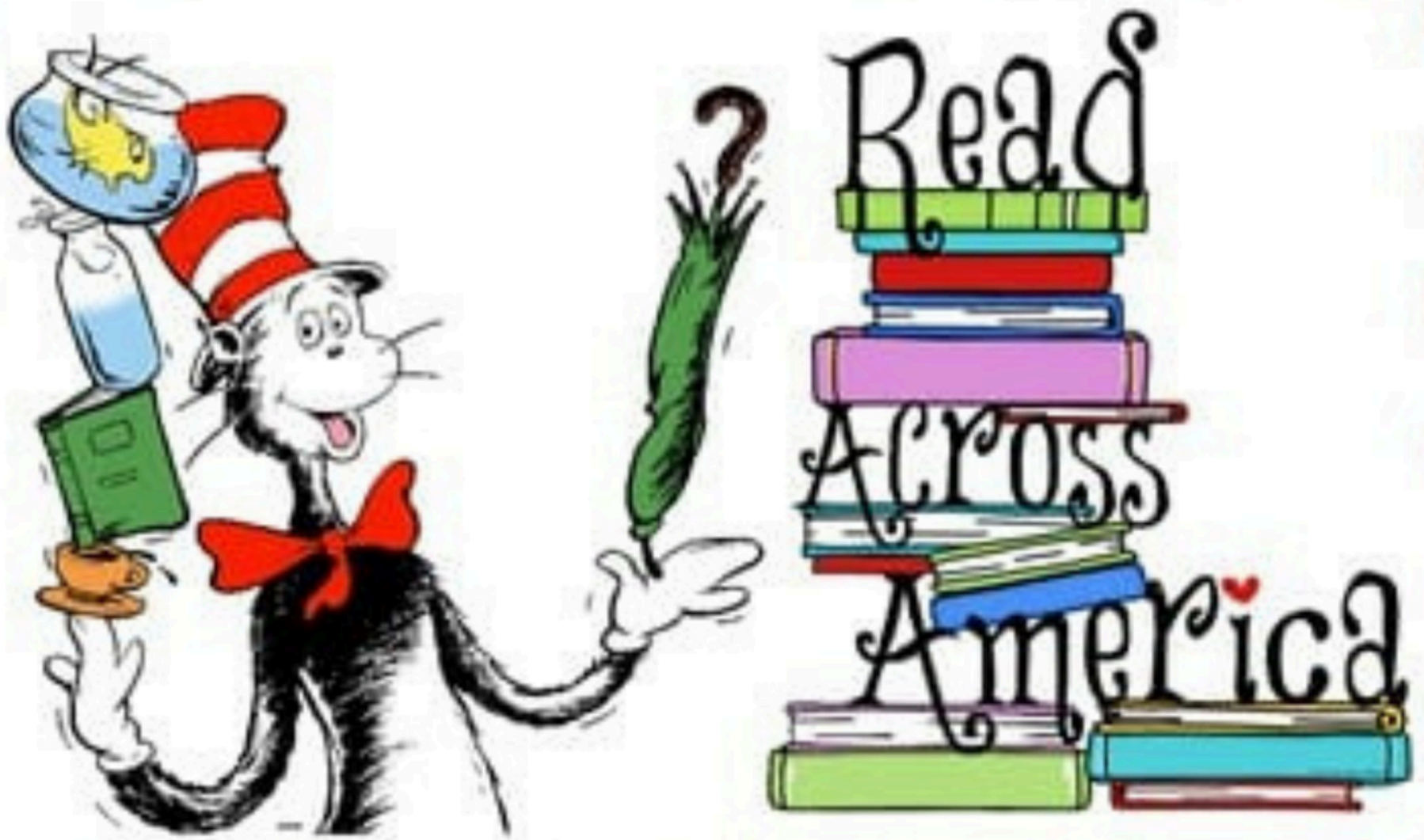
# REMINDERS

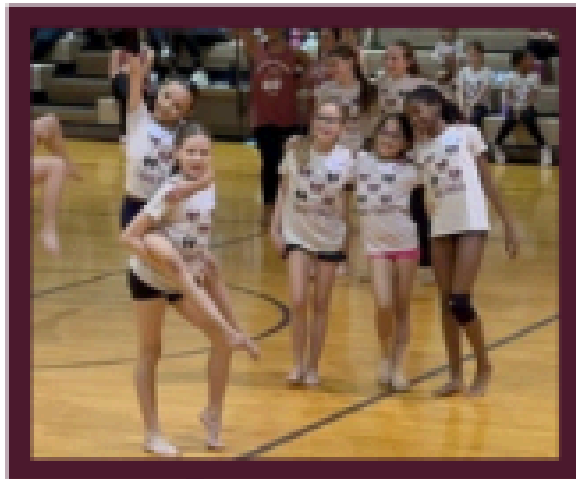

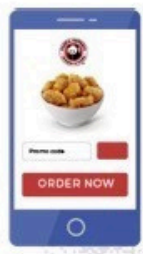
