Reduce stress and confusion during weather events

Notification Process

Superintendent determines school closure

Families notified via phone, email, website, and social media

Announcements made as early as possible (typically by 6:00 a.m.)

Students will follow a modified bell schedule, and attendance will be recorded in Infinite Campus for each period. Below is a chart of what students may expect while learning on remote status during a class period.
