- Drop-Off and Pick-Up will be at the Dining Hall on the Vaughn Road Campus (VRC) at 3240 Vaughn Road, Montgomery, AL 36106. (View Map Below)
- Pick up and drop off times are flexible. If you need to drop-off later or pick-up earlier than the suggested time, please let one of the Camp Eagle Directors know or email [campeagle@montgomeryacademy.org](mailto:campeagle@montgomeryacademy.org).
- Your child should bring a lunch and a water bottle every day. These items should be labeled with your child's first and last name. Water bottle refilling stations are available to students throughout the day.
- Snacks will be provided mid-morning and mid-afternoon.
- Electronic devices are not permitted.
- Campers should arrive each day wearing comfortable clothes to play in: t-shirt, shorts, and sneakers are recommended.
- On Water Days (more information below), your child should arrive with their bathing suit underneath their regular clothes and sunscreen should already be applied before arriving at camp. Please pack a bag with an extra set of clothes, towel, and sunscreen. Make sure all items are properly labeled.
- You may park in the designated parking lot or temporarily park on the curb for quick drop-off and pick-up.

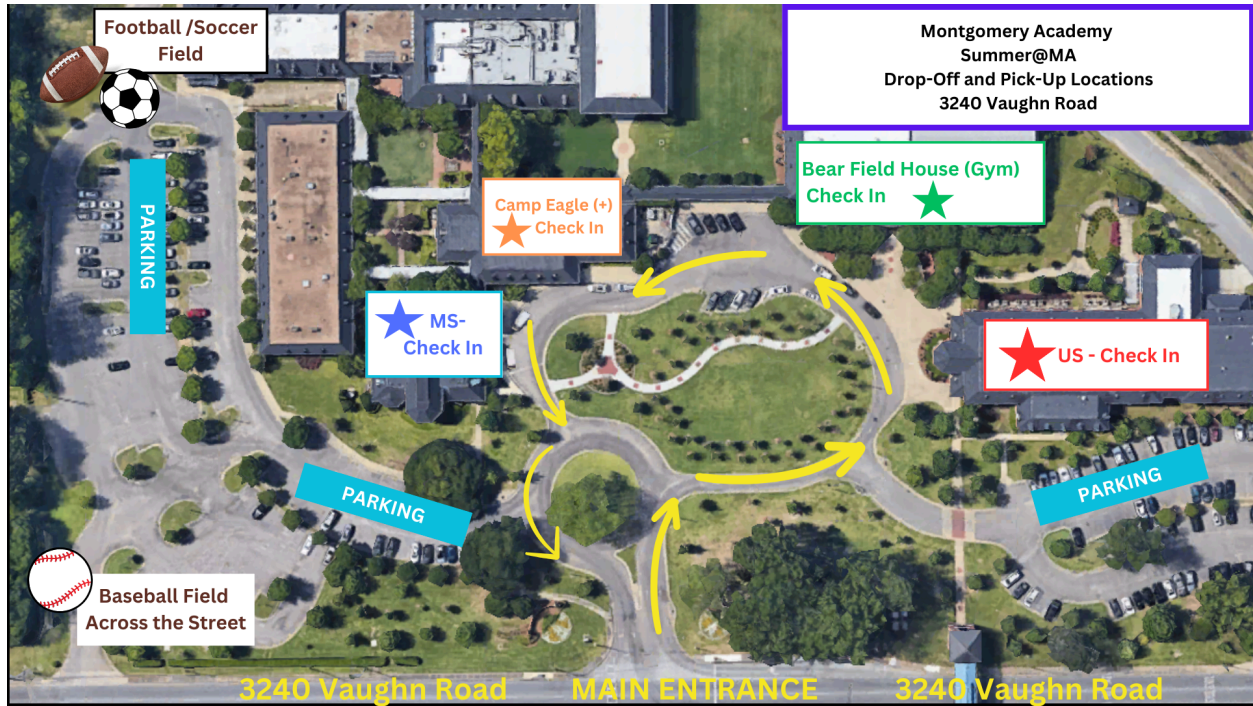

# Policies and Procedures

## BEHAVIOR POLICY

At Summer@MA, we are committed to providing a fun, safe, and respectful environment where all campers can make new friends, learn new skills and grow their talents. To make that happen, we ask that all campers follow our behavior guidelines throughout their time at camp.

### Camper Expectations

1. Use kind words and kind actions
2. Listen when someone is talking
3. Keep our hands and feet to ourselves
4. Take care of our stuff and our camp
5. Include others and play fair
6. Stay where we're supposed to be

### What's Not Okay at Camp

1. Hitting, kicking, or hurting others
2. Saying mean things
3. Not listening to grown-ups
4. Running off without permission
5. Breaking or stealing camp things

### Behavior Management Plan

We're here to help your child make better choices. If something goes wrong, here's what might happen:

1. A gentle reminder from a counselor
2. A short break to cool off
3. A note or phone call home
4. A meeting with parents and camp staff
5. Time away or dismissal from camp if the behavior keeps happening

### Let's Work Together

Camp is better when we're all on the same team. You know your child best. If there is anything we should know about your child before they arrive, please let us know.

## LATE PICK UP POLICY

To ensure proper staffing and to respect the time of our instructors and staff, we have implemented the following Late Pick-Up Policy:

A late fee of \$10 per minute will be charged for any pick-up occurring after the designated pick-up time. Repeated late pick-ups may result in dismissal from the program without a refund. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us maintain a smooth and respectful camp environment for all.

## CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

1. A request for refund must be emailed to [summer@montgomeryacademy.org](mailto:summer@montgomeryacademy.org) at least 48 hours before the start of the camp to receive a full refund minus the deposit. It is the caregiver's responsibility to modify or cancel reservations by the deadline if the camper's scheduled attendance changes. Missed days within a session cannot be prorated. Cost is not based on attendance.
  - **Camp Eagle:** Once a camp week has begun, refunds may be granted for medical or emergency circumstances only. An explanation must be provided as well as a doctor's note for medical related circumstances for a refund request to be considered. Additional documentation may be requested by Montgomery Academy. Partial or full refunds for medical or emergency circumstances will be at the discretion of Montgomery Academy after reviewing the request.
  - **Enrichment Camps:** Because Enrichment camps are operated by third party vendors, no refunds can be granted for Enrichment camps once they have begun.
2. If Montgomery Academy must cancel a camp due to low enrollment, you will be notified at least a full week prior to camp starting and issued a refund for any payment made. Montgomery Academy reserves the right to change the details of any camp/session.
