Important New Law

[New Law](#)

SB19 – Effective Jan. 1, 2026

- What is illegal? Making a threat to kill or seriously hurt someone at a school, university, daycare, workplace, medical facility, or house of worship.
- Does “online” count? Yes. This includes social media posts, images, or texts, as well as things said in person.
- The “Just Kidding” Rule: It is still a crime even if you don’t actually plan to carry it out. If the threat is specific enough to make people feel reasonably and continuously afraid for their safety, it is against the law.
- Consequences for Students: Possible MISDEMEANOR charge on your record. School consequences could range and include a possible suspension and possible recommendation for expulsion.
- Interventions for Students: May include a referral to counseling or wellness, and a referral to the Behavior Threat Assessment process.

Parent Square, Aeries, Homelink Information

ParentSquare/Aeries/Homelink Users can fine-tune their notification settings for posts for each school and district. For General Announcements, you can select Digest, Instant, or choose to turn off notifications altogether (excluding Urgent Alerts and notices.) You can choose to receive email, text, and/or app notifications. We do encourage parents and students to turn on the Instant Text messages so that you can receive timely OHS information directly to your phone. Students will only receive text messages if we have their cell phone on file in Aeries. To learn how to set up your notifications, [please review this document](#). Parents/Guardians also will receive weekly emails/texts from Aeries that send direct information about student grades and attendance. If texting alerts are set up this will go directly to your phone. Although it is automatically set up for you, you can [review the instructions here](#) and you can adjust the date of the week and time you receive these messages.

Attention All Drivers!

Unauthorized Parking Will Result in Tickets and Towing!

To ensure safety and convenience of everyone we are strictly enforcing parking regulations.

Please be aware that parking in the following designated areas without proper authorization will result in a parking ticket AND your vehicle being towed at your expense. Possible revocation of parking privileges.

- Senior Spots - Painted parking spot and must include OHS parking pass. (Seniors Only)
- Staff Parking - Designated for authorized staff member's only. Clearly marked as STAFF in the parking spot. (Must have New OHS STAFF DECAL)
- Visitor Parking - Reserved for **Visitors only**. (Clearly marked Visitor)
- Handicap Parking - Must have a handicap placard.
- Other open spots - Must have a current OHS Parking Pass.

Why is this important?

Accessibility: Ensures those with mobility challenges to have convenient access.

Operational Efficiency: Staff parking allows our team to perform their duties effectively.

Respect for Designated Areas: It maintains order and fairness for all.

If you are unsure where to park please, please ask for clarification. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us maintain a safe and organized parking environment.

Parent drop off reminders

Please remember the back parking area is for bus drop off and pick up only. Also when dropping off in the front, please DO NOT BLOCK LANES. Pull forward and have students exit quickly and safely. Please do not allow your student to jump out of your car on Cirby Way. Thank you!
