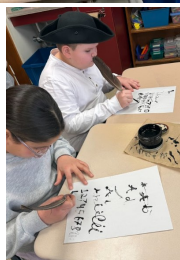
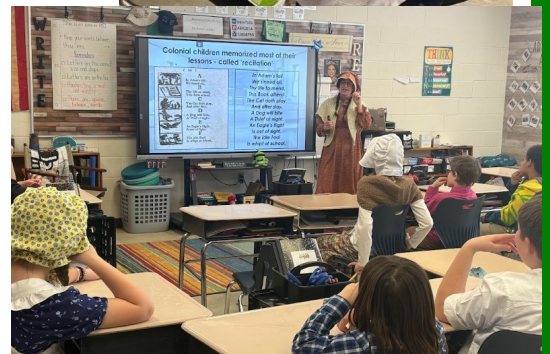
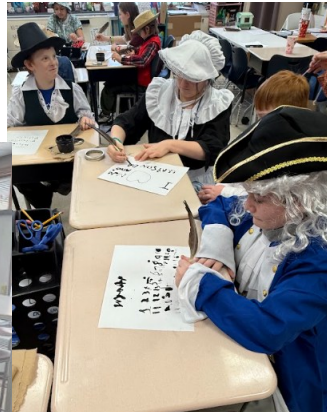


Grade 4 Colonial day—one of our students favorite traditions!
