Kindergarten Registration Now Open for 2026-2027

We are excited to welcome the newest members of our school community! So far, **143 children have been registered** for the upcoming school year, and there is still plenty of time to register your child.



Eligibility

Kindergarten is open to any child who will be five (5) years old on or before **October 15, 2026**.

How to Register

All families must complete the [New Student Enrollment Form](#) to begin the process.

Undecided about Enrollment? If your child meets the age requirement but you have concerns about their developmental readiness, we still encourage you to complete the registration form. This provides us with the most accurate information for staffing and resource planning.

Update on Weather-Related School Closures

Our district has transitioned to remote learning days for all weather-related school closures for the remainder of the 2025-2026 school year. On these days, students will complete assignments asynchronously from home. These remote learning

days will not be added to the end of the school year calendar.

Key Information:

- **IEP/504 Meetings:** All previously scheduled meetings will proceed as planned, unless there are power outages.
- **School-Specific Details:** Each school has provided detailed procedures for remote learning days. Please visit our school website for more information on [weather-related closures](#).

Food Service During Remote Learning Days

We will continue to provide meals for students during remote learning days.

- **Meal Distribution:** Students who have signed up for the meal service have already received non-perishable meals to have on hand. Another meal will be sent home after each remote learning day to replenish their supply.

Mark Your Calendars: Key Dates for the FY27 Budget

The FY27 budget season is here. Below are the essential dates for community members to stay informed and participate in the process.

- **March:** The process begins with School Board budget workshops on **March 11th and 12th**, followed by the First Reading of the school budget on **March 19th**.
- **April:** April is your chance to be heard. The Town Manager and Superintendent will present the budget on **April 1st**. Public hearings are scheduled for the Town Council meeting on **April 15th**

and the School Board meeting on **April 16th**.

- **May:** Final decisions will be made this month. The School Board and Town Council will hold their second readings and budget votes on **May 7th** and **May 20th**, respectively.
- **June:** The process concludes with the School Budget Validation Referendum on **Tuesday, June 9th**, where the community will cast the final vote.

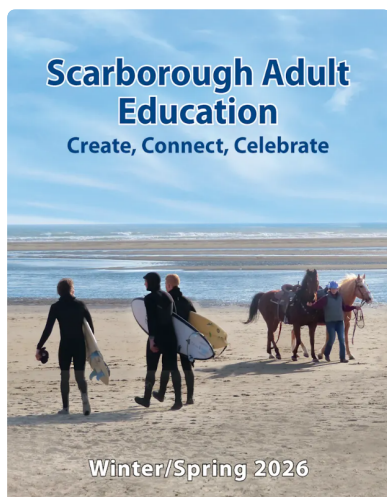


Need Help with Food?
