Nutrition Services: (Debra Rice)- Local School Wellness Policy is reviewed and updated annually. 1. The District wellness policy is continued to be updated with information including staff wellness. The draft is still in the process of being developed, and will be presented to the committee when completed, 2. When the first lunch talk group was completed, "good" feedback was provided by SSHS students (8 students joined the face to face meeting) both positive and negative with input. The students were explained the rules and regulations that the District must follow versus meals provided by outside restaurants, how its program is funded, etc.3. Child nutrition will ensure outside delivery vendors are vetted and cleared within their own organization, to be verified by COOP practice. Otherwise The procurement Department will be

contacted for background checks and clearance guidance , as directed by the District Chief of Police.
