The Laguna Beach High School Counselors are beginning the course registration process for fall 2026. As a new parent/student to the Laguna Beach Unified School District (LBUSD), we would like to welcome you to Laguna Beach High School.

All new students **must complete** the online New Student Enrollment process before completing course registration. Details for enrollment may be found on the LBUSD website (www.lbusd.org). Please enroll using the Aeries online portal, which opened on **February 11, 2026**, and submit all of your enrollment documentation via the Aeries document upload feature.

All enrollment paperwork must be submitted and approved **before** a counseling appointment is scheduled/confirmed at LBHS. Our counselors are only available to conduct individual meetings with incoming families once the enrollment process is completed. Counseling Assistant Missy Palino (mpalino@lbusd.org) will contact you in the middle of May or early August to schedule your counseling appointment and to complete the registration process. You may also contact the Registrar, Ellen Oxales, at eoxales@lbusd.org for further assistance.

Freshman Core Academic Courses will be selected for students based on academic performance, grades, assessment data, and current teacher recommendations.
