SAT Device check:

If you are registered to take the SAT this Wednesday and you have not completed the required device check, you must see Dr. Bounds Monday or Tuesday in order to ensure that your device is ready for testing. You may not test on Wednesday if you have not completed the device check.

SAT Testing Day Instructions:

Date: Wednesday, March 4

Time: Testing begins no later than 8:30 AM. Plan to arrive between 8:00 am – 8:20 am

Check-in: Gym Lobby; Bring Photo ID (no copies are allowed- must be original drivers license, permit, or Northview ID)

What to bring: Charged FCS device, charger, calculator (must be approved by College Board), photo ID, snack/water, pencil

What NOT to bring: phones, airpods, smart watches, ipads, other devices, hats/hoodies (not allowed per College Board)

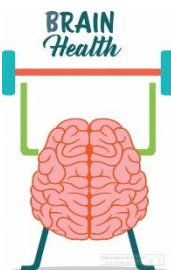


ACT Testing March 26, 2026: Juniors, if you are interested in taking the ACT and have not signed up yet, please email Dr. Bounds @ boundsc1@fultonschools.org in order to ensure you are registered.

ACT Device check: There will be a mandatory device check for the ACT on Wednesday, March 11 during Advisement in the cafeteria. You will need to bring your FCS device AND your calculator if you are going to use a handheld calculator on test day.



Students taking a virtual AP Class through GAVS or FVS: If you are enrolled in a virtual AP class through GAVS or FVS and you have not seen Dr. Bounds for a join code, the deadline to register is next Tuesday, March 10.
