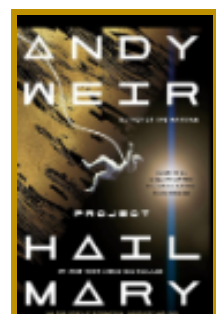
CLUBS/CORE:

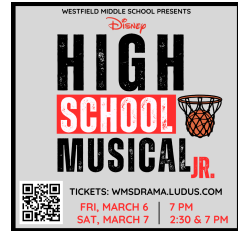
