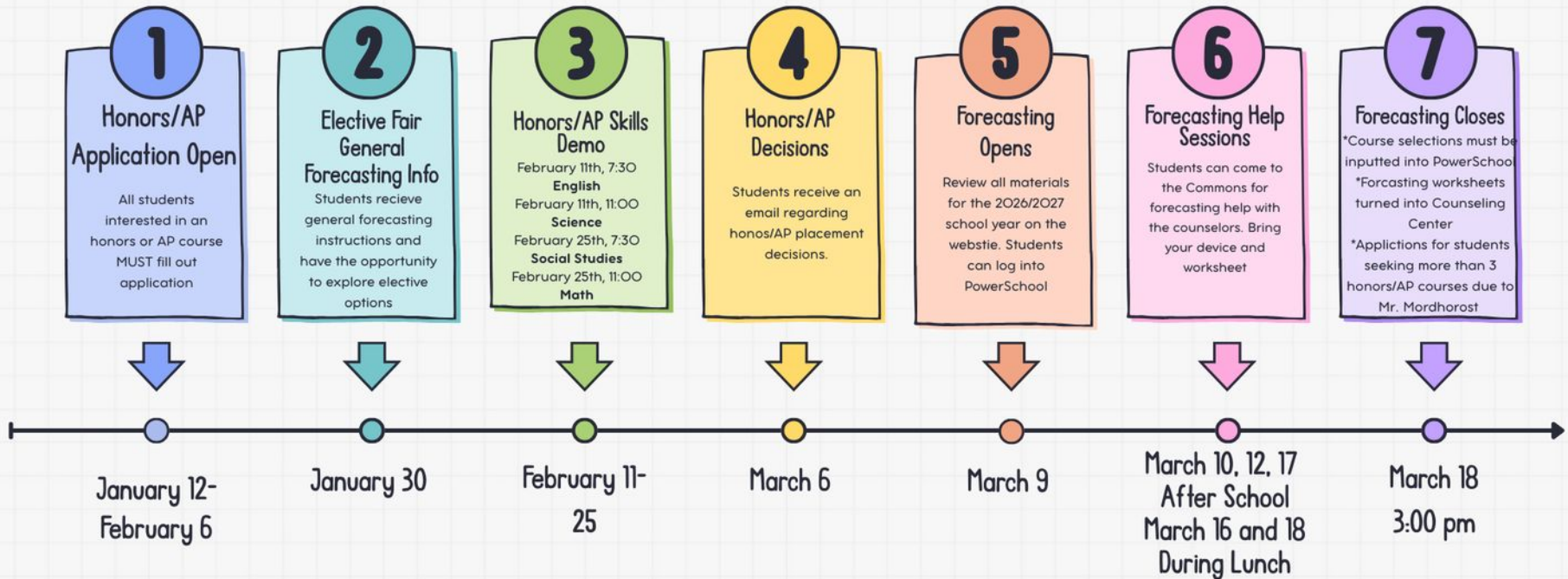


SCHEDULE CHANGES

FORECASTING TIMELINE



“Typical” 10th Grade Courses

1. Theology II
2. English II or H. English II
3. Math- next course in the sequence
4. Science- Biology, Physics, or H. Physics
5. World Language
6. PE /Dance/Weight Training (*EB does not count*)
7. Electives- Art credits, Computer Science credits, etc.
8. Optional: 0 period classes, EB WT, Band, Robotics

- English III/AP English Lang 1 credit
- US History/AP US History 1 credit
- 3rd year of Math (Algebra II for 4 year college) 1 credit

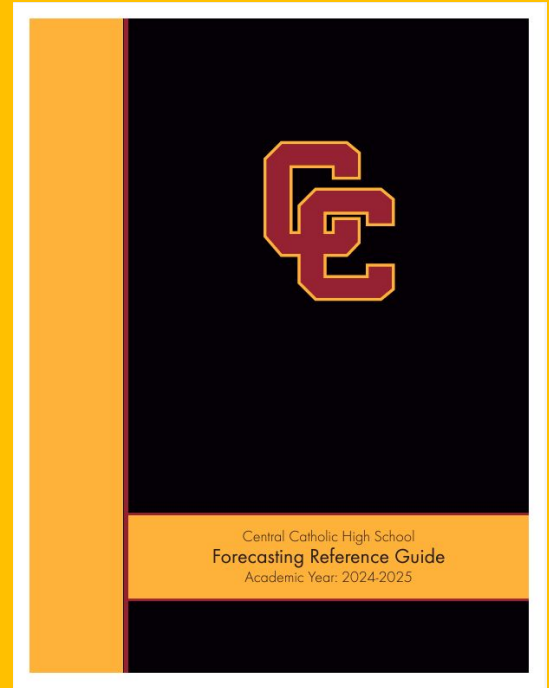

ADMISSION STANDARDS FOR MOST OR and WA PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES

Most require satisfactory completion of:

- 4 years of **English**
- 3 years of **Mathematics** including Algebra II and higher
- 3 years of **Science**
- 3 years of **Social Studies**
- 2 years of the same **World Language**

**Requirements may vary for the different Oregon public universities, specifically requiring a minimum of a C- or better Please check individual websites.*

**Oregon public universities are test optional -- SAT and/or ACT scores are not required.*

ADMISSIONS STANDARDS FOR PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES IN CALIFORNIA

Must Complete 15 college prep courses with a C or better:

- **4 years of English**
- **3 years of Mathematics including Algebra II and higher (a fourth is strongly encouraged)**
- **2 years of Lab Science**
- **2 years of History**
- **2 years of the same World Language:**
- **One year of course of visual and performing arts in the same discipline (music/theater, visual arts)**
- **One year of college preparatory elective**

REGARDING AP/HONORS CLASSES

Applications for honors courses are due Friday Feb 6th

- Instructions and skill demonstration dates sent to CCHS email
- This does not commit you to these choices (you will make final decisions when forecasting officially opens)
- Students will be notified of decision by before March 6th
- If you forecast for more than 3 Honors/AP courses in one semester you must complete the approval process by the forecasting deadline. Details in reference guide.
- All students who are not in an Honors course in that subject must complete a skills demonstration:
 - Wednesday Late Starts: Feb 12 (English) and Feb 19 (Math)
 - Wednesday Extended Lunches: Feb 12 (Science) and Feb 19 (Social Studies)
 - One make up time after school: Thursday, February 20
