## *What We Are Learning*



AG - Students are developing technical knowledge and skills related to animal systems by identifying and classifying breeds of goats.

Tech Apps I - Students will be learning block coding and practicing their problem-solving skills.

Leadership - Students will identify character traits and determine which traits are good, need to be improved, and which ones will help them be more successful in life.

## *Talk About Learning*

AG - Students can talk about terminology used in the goat industry, along with physical characteristics.

Tech Apps I - Scratch.mit is a good place to see more block coding for practice.

Leadership - Discuss what character traits you see in your child that you are proud of or that they need work on. Often, they think they have a character trait, but they perceive it differently than we do as adults.
