Lemont High School is a comprehensive public high school serving students from grades 9-12. Our mission is for all students to become life-long, independent learners and productive citizens in a rapidly changing world.

Lemont High School District 210 is a one-school, high school district serving an area of more than 31 square miles in the southwest suburban Chicagoland area. The district's boundaries cover Lemont Township (Cook County) and the south portion of Downers Grove Township (DuPage County). The Village of Lemont is the single municipality contained within the district's boundaries, which also include Argonne National Laboratory. In addition to Lemont, the district also serves portions of Darien, Downers Grove and Woodridge.

Number and Location of Offices:

The offices for Lemont High School and Lemont High School District 210 are located at 800 Porter Street in Lemont.

Approximate Number of Full and Part-Time Employees:

Lemont High School District 210 employs between 200-300 full- and part-time employees.

Operating Budget:

The operating budget adopted by the Lemont High School District 210 Board of Education for the 2025-26 school year is \$34,245,669.

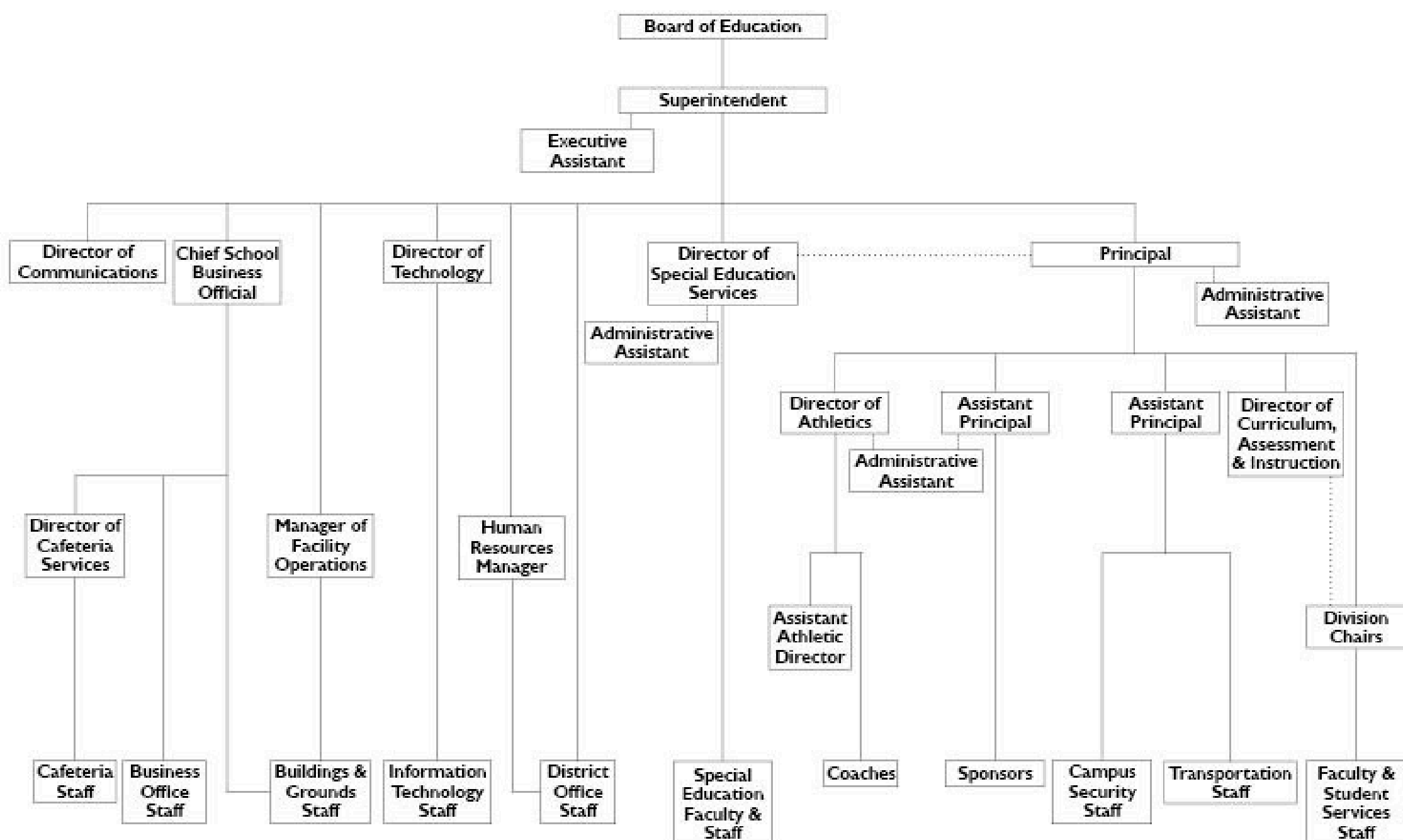
