FEES PAID BY LE LYCÉE FRANÇAIS DE LOS ANGELES FOR THE EXCHANGE VISITOR (EV):

1. DS-2019 Fee: \$2,000-\$4,000. Since the School has its own visa program, we provide this service free of charge to those J-1 teachers we hire and any J-2 dependents.
2. The Fingerprinting Fee \$97-100 is paid directly to Live Scan on behalf of the Employee.
3. All EVs are gifted Le Lycée-branded Spirit Wear: t-shirt, sweatpants, jacket, and cap.

FEES EXCHANGE VISITOR (EV) MUST PAY:

The basic living cost in Los Angeles for 2026 is estimated between \$3,200 and \$6,800 per month for a single person, depending on lifestyle, neighborhood, and housing type. Rent remains the largest monthly expense, followed by transportation, groceries, and utilities. While certain areas, such as Koreatown and East LA, offer more affordable options, neighborhoods like Beverly Hills and Santa Monica are significantly more expensive, making budgeting essential for anyone relocating or living in Los Angeles. 1. I-901 Fee: \$220 (payable directly on the FMJ website.)
2. DS-160 Fee: \$185 (payable directly on the CEAC website.)
3. The School does not charge a sponsor fee = \$0.00.
4. The School does not charge a foreign or domestic third-party fee = \$0.00.
5. The School does not charge a visa fee = \$0.00.
6. The School does not charge a SEVIS fee = \$0.00.

 - Power:
 - Small Apartments (1–2 people): \$60–\$120 per month.
 - Medium Homes (3–4 people): \$120–\$250 per month.

- Water: \$45 - \$130 (average \$80)
- Home Wi-Fi & Cable TV: \$100 - \$210 (average \$160)
- Gas & Heating: \$35 - \$85 (average \$60)
- Mobile Phone Service: Range: \$15 - \$65 (average) depending upon the requested features. Often, EVs retain their foreign mobile service and use it instead of acquiring an American phone number/service.

9. Health Insurance: The School offers each Employee the opportunity to opt into the School's Health Insurance Program with Anthem Blue Cross. The School pays 75% of the Employee Only premium. Employees pay the remaining 25% for themselves and 100% for any dependents. Since the effective date is November 1st of each year, the School also requires EVs to provide proof of health insurance from their home country, as per [22 CFR 62.14]. They must also sign a STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE FOR HEALTH INSURANCE, which assures that the EV will maintain the required health insurance for themselves and any J-2 dependents for the length of stay in the U.S. Range: \$215 HMO - \$975 PPO. **For more details, see 2025-2026 EMPLOYEE BENEFIT MONTHLY PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS.**

10. Transportation: Most EVs can walk to school, carpool, or arrange their own way. **For more details, see LA LOCAL TRANSPORTATION - FEBRUARY 2026.**

Fare can be paid using cash (exact change) or a TAP card \$0.35 or \$0.25 for seniors and disabled. The regular fare is good for 2 hrs of unlimited transfers in one direction.
