

Title: Open Enrollment

Open Enrollment is the process by which parents/guardians residing in an Iowa school district may enroll their children into another Iowa school district. The District participates in open enrollment both as a sending and receiving District in accordance with the open enrollment statute and the rules and regulations published by the Iowa Department of Education.

Except as may be required by law, students cannot be transported to the receiving district from a bus stop in their resident district. Open enrollment students may access transportation services as normally available within the District at an established bus stop. Transportation is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Low income families may qualify for assistance for transportation.

In all open enrollments into the District, the District maintains the right to deny or assign a specific attendance area or program based upon insufficient classroom space as defined by the maximum class size established annually by the Superintendent. Procedures will be maintained to facilitate this process.
