

Title: Special Minor's Restricted License

A special minor restricted license issued by the Iowa Department of Motor Vehicles allows students to drive independently to school or work with some restrictions. The student must be at least 14 ½ years old, hold a valid instruction permit, and complete an Iowa-approved driver education course.

To obtain the Special Minor's Restricted License, the parent/guardian must complete and sign the Affidavit for Special Minor's Restricted License form and have it signed by school authorities to verify enrollment.

The forms as approved by the Iowa Department of Transportation shall be the documents used for this purpose.

The Superintendent, Board, and the District shall not be responsible for actions of the student applicant which pertain to the use of the driver's license, if issued.
