

Special Events Dress Code

Students are required to be appropriately dressed for the event. Appropriate dress options include:

A. Pants (dress slacks, khakis) paired with a blazer and a button-down shirt or pants and a collared shirt.

B. A suit.

- If you wear a suit jacket or coat, a shirt must also be worn. The shirt must not be see-through or have cut-outs.
- All shirts must have no more than two (2) buttons undone.

C. A dressy blouse paired with dress pants or skirt.

D. A dress.

- One shoulder, spaghetti strap, sleeveless, and halter style dresses and blouses ARE permitted.
- Bodycon/form fitting spandex dresses ARE NOT permitted.
- Fully backless or strapless garments, mesh/see-through fabrics, and visible ARE NOT permitted.
- All shirts/tops/dresses must fully cover the midriff, and necklines should not expose cleavage.
- All dresses and skirts, including the slit, must be no shorter than 2" above the knee.
- Proper undergarments are to be worn and should not be visible.
- Students wearing dresses above the knee are required to also wear modesty shorts, bike shorts, Spanx, or cheer shorts under their skirts/dresses.

E. Footwear

- Open-toed shoes ARE permitted at these events.
- Shoes may not have more than a 3" heel and it is highly encouraged that they have an ankle strap.
- Only non-marking shoes are allowed.
