### **Space Expedition (incoming 1st-5th with a max of 10 students), June 8-11**

Children will enjoy fun, hands-on activities such as building rockets, creating galaxy art, and studying planets.

### **Science Wonder Lab (incoming 2nd-5th), June 8-11 or June 15-18**

Get ready for a hands-on journey into the world of science, where curious minds will explore, discover, and innovate. This camp offers an immersive experience designed to build your child's passion for STEAM.

### **Fun with Snap Circuits (incoming 3rd-6th), June 8-11 or June 22-25**

Learn how simple electricity works by building circuits — sparking fun and creativity.

### **A Barnyard Moosical (incoming 1st-3rd with a max of 12 students), June 8-11**

A mini musical about a group of talented animals on an unforgettable farm. Students will bring the story to life by learning songs and lines, then perform for their families at the end of the week.

### **Jurassic Park (incoming 1st-5th with a max of 10 students), June 15-18**

### **All Things Art (incoming 3rd-6th), June 15-18 or July 13-16**

Students will build confidence as they learn different forms of art such as painting and crafts.

### **BotLab Robotics (incoming 4th-6th), June 15-18**

Students will learn how robotics are used and needed in every day life by constructing and operating their own.

### **Broadway Beat (incoming 3rd-5th with a max of 10 students), June 22-25**

Students will explore 7 classical musicals. Through games, music, vocal exercises, and personalized coaching, campers will prepare a solo or small group piece to perform for their families.

### **Elementary Band (incoming 4th-5th), June 29-July 2**

### **Tinkering with 3D (incoming 4th-6th), June 29-July 2**

Students will create 3D objects using TinkerCAD and get to see their creations come to life.

### **Printmaking Techniques (incoming 6th-8th), July 13-16**

Students will explore a variety of printmaking including monoprints, linocutting, and etching.

### **Marble Madness (incoming 4th-6th), July 13-16**

Students will build marble mazes and learn the history of marbles and how to play the game.

### **Self Defense & Stranger Awareness (incoming 3rd-6th with a max of 12 students), July 13-16**

Learn practical skills to stay safe and confident in real world situations. Led by a Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu Black Belt, the program focuses on awareness, verbal boundaries, and safe escape techniques.
