



## Work Study Opportunities at Archbishop Hoban

The purpose of Hoban's Work Study Program is to help finance the student's education and benefit the school at the same time. All earnings are applied directly to the student's tuition account.

### 1) Summer Work Program

The student is assigned to one of these three sessions.

June 8 - 25    June 29 – July 16    July 27 – August 13

They work Monday-Thursdays from 8am-3pm. The work involves assisting the Hoban maintenance staff in cleaning the school in preparation for the next school year. Students can sign up for this through their Hoban online account. The tuition credit is \$12.50/hour worked. There will be more students applying than work opportunities. Those assigned will be selected based on financial need.

### 2) After School Work Program

This takes place during the school year on days school is in session. The student may work 1-5 days per week for 1-2 hours per day. The work will involve assisting the Hoban maintenance staff in cleaning the school in preparation for the next school day. Students can sign up for this through their Hoban online account. The tuition credit is \$12.50/hour worked. The number of days worked is up to the family. The student can start and/or stop at any time during the school year.

### 3) Parent Work Study Program

This takes place throughout the school year. The parents/legal guardians of students can work any event or opportunity where adult assistance is needed. Most of these opportunities involve Hoban sporting events where ticket takers are needed. Parents can sign up for this through their student's Hoban online account. The tuition credit is \$12.50/hour worked. There will be an opportunity email sent, to all signed up parents, prior to each season. Those assigned will be selected based on financial need.

### Process for signing up through the student's Hoban Online Account

The Work Study application can be found in the Resources section of the student's [hoban.myschoolapp.com](http://hoban.myschoolapp.com) beginning on April 15, 2026.

Don't use the student being involved in extracurricular activities as an excuse not to participate in Work Study. We are flexible enough to handle most situations.

If you are not signed up for Work Study, you will not receive an email notice as the programs get started. If you are even considering one of these programs, then the suggestion is to sign up. You can decide later not to participate.
