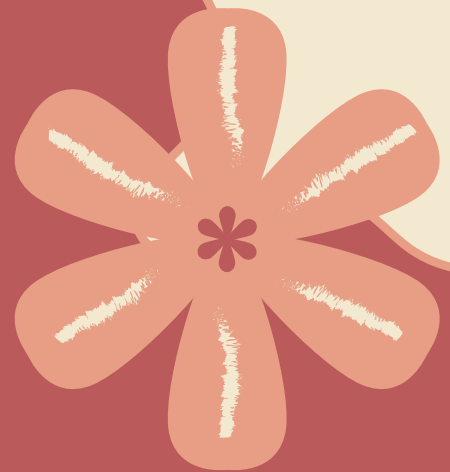
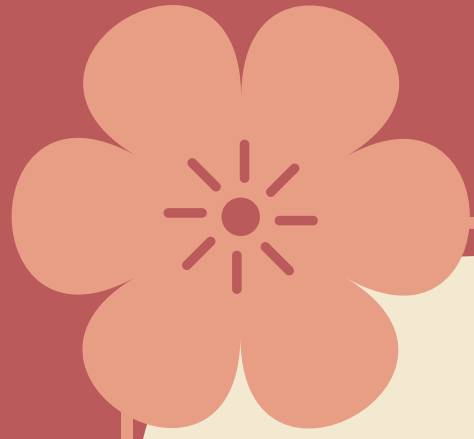

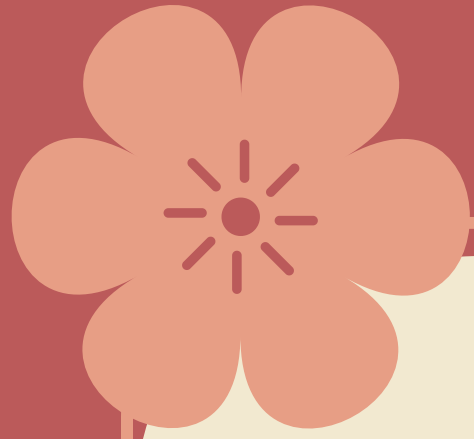




Problem


Can we provide free feminine hygiene products in all high school bathrooms and locker room?

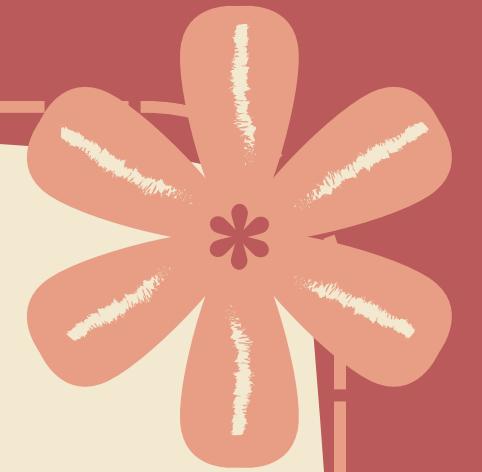
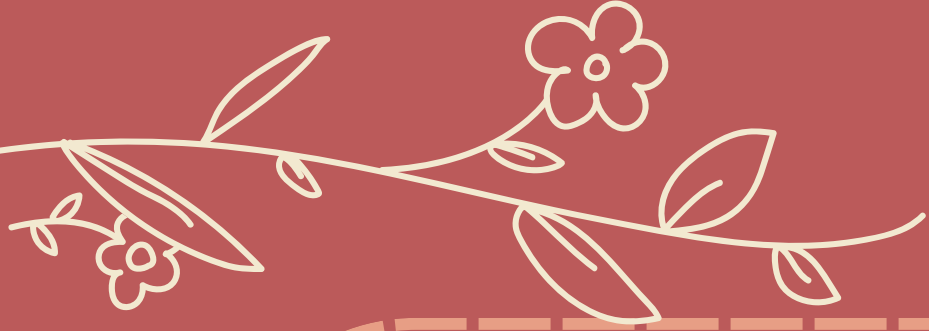




Numbers

Estimate

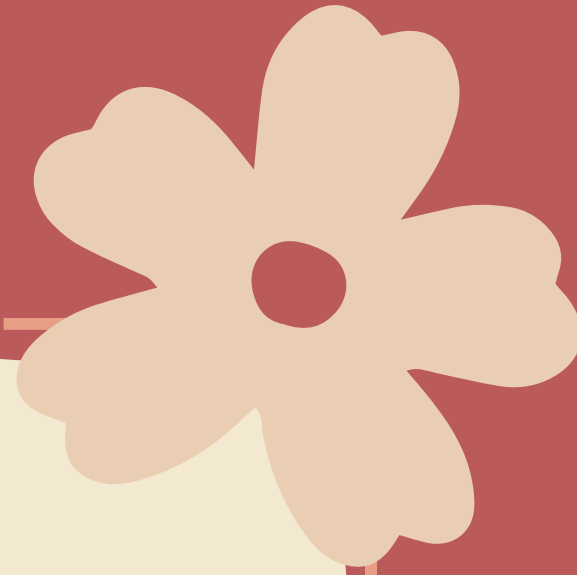
\$270 per bathroom to get it off the ground
