- Opal Apples are medium to large varietal and showcase bright yellow skin covered in tiny dark brown dots and light russeting around the stem.
- Opal Apples have a sweet, subtly tart, and tangy taste with pleasant fruity nuances.
- Opal Apples are a source of vitamin C to strengthen the immune system.
