All South High School students have the opportunity to explore a wide variety of potential career paths at Career Day on Wednesday. Students in grades 9-12 will get an up-close and personal look at their choice of 71 careers and speak with representatives from 69 organizations.

Each student has signed up for three 25-minute sessions to learn more about a specific potential career that matches their interests. They were given the options to choose from a large list of careers including doctor, HVAC specialist, 911 dispatcher, lawyer, coach, and many others.
