## 4 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

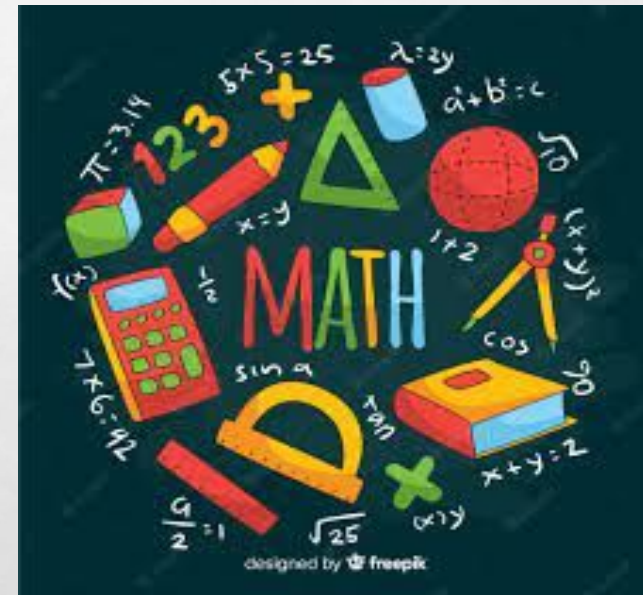
- **English 12**

- **AP English Literature**
  - must score a 480 on SAT Reading
  - may be concurrently enrolled in LSSU's English 110 & 111

## 4 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

- Algebra II or Honors Algebra II
- Pre-Calculus
  - If you have a B- or higher in Geometry and Algebra II
- Senior math experience—all CTE classes & some science courses
- Personal Finance

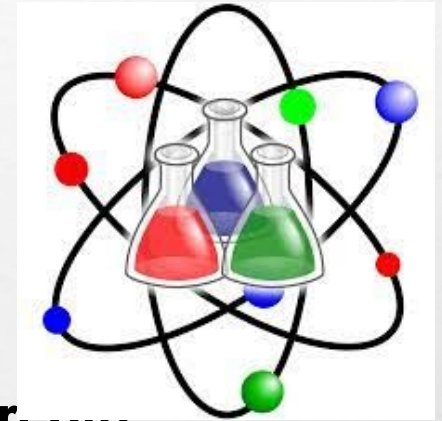

# SCIENCE

## 3 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION



- Earth & Space Science
- Anatomy & Physiology
- Health Science 1 or 2 (senior math credit)
- Natural Resources (2 hours, senior math credit)
- AP Biology
  - must score a 480 on SAT Reading
- Physics (senior math credit)
  - if you have done well in Honors Chemistry
  - if you are considering studying engineering or medicine in college
- College Chemistry 115 (senior math)
  - must score a 570 on SAT Math

# **SOCIAL STUDIES**

## **3 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION**



- **US History, World History, Civics, & Economics REQUIRED**
- **May take as electives:**
  - **AP US History (must score a 480 on SAT Reading)**
  - **AP US Government (must score a 480 on SAT Reading)**
  - **AP Psychology (must score a 480 on SAT Reading)**
  - **AP World History (must score a 480 on SAT Reading)**

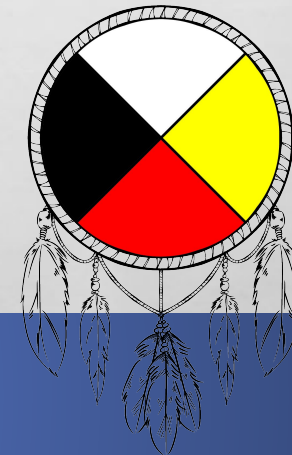

# SENIORS BEWARE!



## IF YOU WANT TO ATTEND A SELECTIVE COLLEGE:

## IF YOU WANT TO PLAY A COLLEGE SPORT:

- You must be NCAA eligible
  - 16 core academic courses
    - 4 English
    - 3 Math
    - 2 Science
    - 2 Social Studies
    - 5 additional core courses
