The **Shamrock Blast Newsletter** is a curated district newsletter designed to be a **useful, easy-to-read resource** for students, families, staff, and the broader Westfield community. The following guidelines must be followed in order to create an informative, organized, and positive reader experience.

The following guidelines help us:

- Keep the newsletter organized and readable
- Share information that is meaningful and relevant
- Maintain a clear purpose and identity for the Blast
- Balance school, district, and community content

Our goal is for every edition of the Blast to provide value—not only to those connected to our schools, but to the city as a whole. The more people who read the newsletter, and who read more of it, the better for everyone!

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## **Newsletter Sections**

- **District News** – District-wide announcements and updates
- **Upcoming Events** – School events first; community events if family-friendly and accessible
- **Sports** – School sports and school-affiliated athletic programs
- **Arts** – School-based arts programs and organizations
- **Resources** – Nurse notes, district calendar, school-affiliated resources
- **Community** – Outside organizations, events, meetings, scholarships, camps, and the district job portal

All sections follow the same submission format and benefit guidelines.

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## Submission Elements

All submissions must follow the format below, regardless of section. Please submit items to [WWS Communications](mailto:comms@wws.k12.in.us) (comms@wws.k12.in.us).

### Headline\*

- **\*Required**
- Up to **75 characters**, including spaces

### Blurb\*

- **\*Required**
- Up to **400 characters**, including spaces
- Include the most important details (what, who, when, where); how it benefits our students, families, community

### Optional Button Link

- One button maximum
- Links to **one webpage only**
- Helpful if details won't fit in the blurb or graphic
- Button text: **up to 25 characters**, including spaces
  - Examples: *Learn More, Buy Tickets, Register Here*





## **Optional Graphics (Two Accepted Options)**

Including a graphic is optional.

Why only these two sizes?

- Both fit cleanly within the newsletter layout
- Both provide flexibility depending on the content
- Both can easily be reused on Facebook, Instagram, and other platforms

We intentionally chose standard social media sizes to avoid requiring custom, newsletter-only graphics.

If you choose to submit one, you may use **either** of the following formats:





## Graphic Option 1: Full-Width

- Size: **1,200 × 628 px**
- Known as the **Facebook Ad size** in Canva
- Displays full-width across the news item

This option works well when:

- You have more information to share visually
- You want the graphic to serve as a strong header

## Graphic Option 2: Square

- Size: **1:1 square format** (Instagram-style post)
- Displays **smaller, alongside the text** (typically to the right of the blurb)

This option works well when:

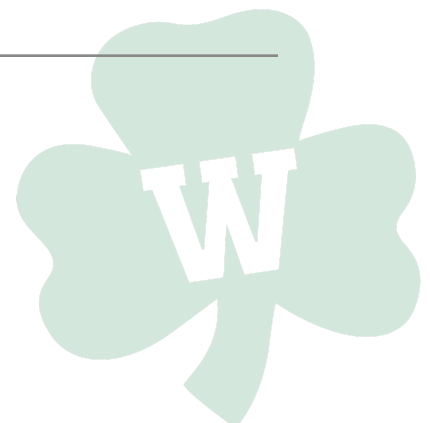
- You already have a square graphic available
- You don't need a full-width header image
- Your graphic is simpler or more visual

## **What We Prioritize**

Submissions are reviewed with the following priorities in mind (not rigid, but generally followed):

- Clear relevance to **WWS students, families, or staff**
- Demonstrated benefit to the **district or community**
- Support for student well-being, learning, enrichment, or connection

We do **not** accept advertisements.

Products or services may be considered **case by case** if messaging clearly demonstrates benefit to students, staff, families, or the community.

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## **Submission Deadlines**

- The Shamrock Blast is published **every other Thursday**
- Submissions are due by **12:00 p.m. (noon) on the Wednesday prior**

Late submissions will **not** be considered for inclusion until the next newsletter.

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## **Important Note on Submission Acceptance**

Submitting content does **not** guarantee inclusion.

Placement depends on:

- Available space
- Overall length and readability of the newsletter
- Volume of submissions in a given week

Westfield Washington Schools news and events will always receive priority, but we will do our best to accommodate other submissions whenever possible.

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## Submission Checklist

Before submitting, please confirm:

- Headline is **75 characters or fewer**
- Blurb is **400 characters or fewer**
- Content benefits WWS students, families, staff, or the community (No advertisements!)
- Optional button links to **one webpage** only
- Button text is **25 characters or fewer**
- Optional graphic is either:
  - 1,200 × 628 px** (full-width), **or**
  - Square (1:1)** format
- Submitted by **Wednesday at noon** before each Blast is sent: Please submit items to [WWS Communications](mailto:comms@wws.k12.in.us) (comms@wws.k12.in.us).
