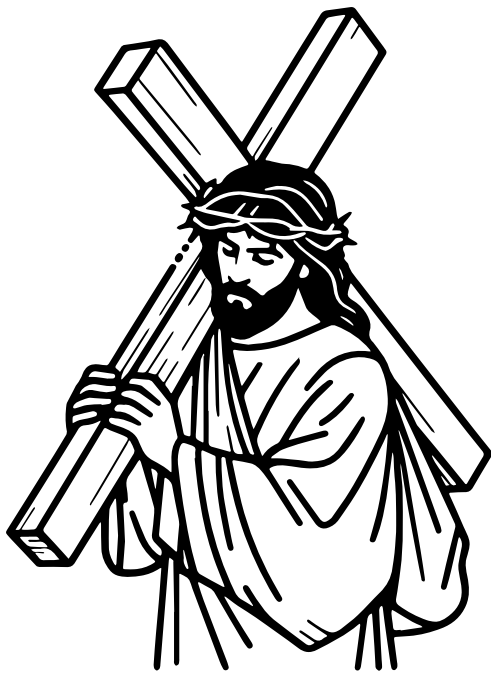

Sacrifice

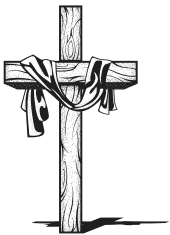
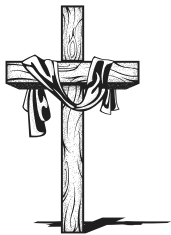
- pass up a special treat and pray for those living in poverty

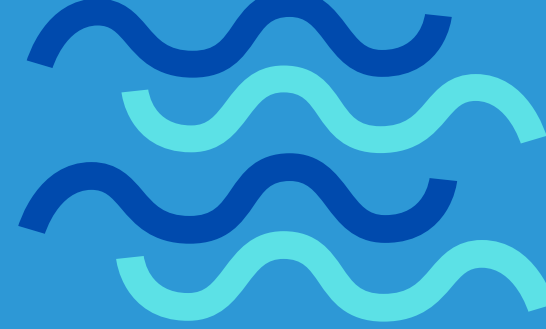

- Plan area, including inflatables, seating, drink booth
- Staff volunteers that check wristbands and monitor inflatables
