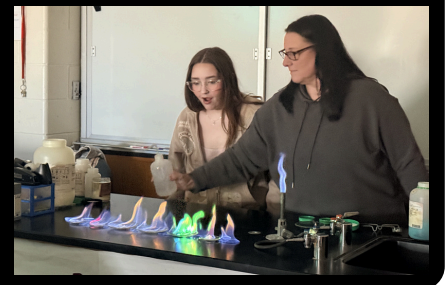
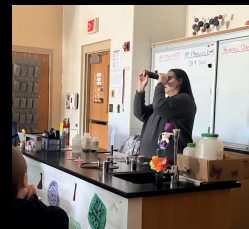

Igniting Curiosity: Chemistry Class Explores Elements Through Fire

Mrs. Smucker's chemistry students recently witnessed a colorful flame test demonstration as an introduction to their upcoming lab. She began by asking how energy could be added to a substance, and a student correctly answered, "Heat."

Demonstrating each element individually, she showed how potassium (a salt) burned purple when ethyl alcohol was added to help it ignite. Strontium, lithium, sodium, and calcium each produced distinct colors – including sodium's glow, similar to that of street lamps. She explained that each element emits a unique wavelength, much like a fingerprint.

Students will soon conduct their own lab, using flame colors and the line spectra emitted by them to determine which elements are present – just like the science behind fireworks.
