

Save Your Tabs for the Ronald McDonald House



Liberty-Curtin Elementary is thrilled to announce our fourth year of this exciting *One Team, One Dream* opportunity to make a difference in the lives of families in need!

This year, Liberty-Curtin Elementary is collaborating with Mill Hall, Renovo, Robb, and Woodward Elementary schools to collect soda tabs for the Grab-a-Tab Program at the Ronald McDonald House in Danville, Pennsylvania. Last year, with the help of Renovo and Woodward Elementary, we collected a combined total of 1,070 pounds of soda tabs—an incredible example of what we can accomplish when we work together as one team.

The Grab-a-Tab Program collects soda tabs and sends them to a recycling center near the Ronald McDonald House. The funds generated from recycling these tabs are used to support families of sick children who are staying at the Ronald McDonald House. Through this *One Team, One Dream* collaboration, our schools are able to support families during some of their most difficult times and make a meaningful, positive impact.

This year, our collective goal is to collect more than 1,200 pounds of soda tabs. In addition to working together toward this goal, we will also host a friendly competition between participating schools. The school with the highest total pounds collected at the end of the contest will be awarded for their outstanding teamwork and effort.

We encourage all students and families to get involved by collecting as many soda tabs as possible. Please feel free to ask family members, friends, churches, and local businesses to help with this effort. Every tab counts, and together we can make a difference. Tabs may be sent to school with your child or turned in at the school office.

We will track our progress throughout the contest and share updates during monthly collective assemblies, where we will announce our total pounds collected and celebrate our progress together. You may begin sending in tabs on Thursday, January 22, and the contest will conclude on Thursday, May 28.
