- March 2-4: In-Person Kindergarten Registration by appointment at WCS Central Office
- April 11: Kindergarten Welcome Days from 8:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. (by appointment) at Vermont
- April 14: Kindergarten Welcome Days from 4:00 p.m.-6:00 p.m. (by appointment) at Vermont

From the Nurse's Office: We are seeing a surge in community-wide illnesses such as influenza, covid, stomach viruses, and common cold viruses. Many of these illnesses share similar symptoms, and it can be difficult to know which one your child may have. If your child is not feeling well, we ask that you:

1. Check their temperature before sending your child to school. If they have a temperature of 100.0 °F or higher, please keep them home. Students should be fever-free for 24 hours with no fever-reducing medication (such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen) before returning to school.
2. If NO fever is present, please give medications for stomachache, headache, coughing, or other symptoms before sending them to school.
3. Students MAY NOT bring medication to school and nurses cannot give ANY medications to a student without a signed medication form.
4. If your child is fever-free, but has a stuffy/runny nose or cough, please encourage them to take precautions to limit the spread of germs until they feel better. This includes frequent hand washing or using hand sanitizer, covering their coughs, etc.
5. Students experiencing stomach virus symptoms (with or without fever) should stay home for at least 24 hours following their last episode of vomiting.

Lost & Found: We have an abundance of items in each building's Lost and Found. If your child is missing any items (coats, jackets, gloves, water bottles, etc.) please ask them to check the Lost and Found.
