A. Essay

A concise essay discussing why you value service to your school and community (approximately 300 words)
Do not include your name or other personal information on this document to ensure anonymity during the selection process. Please use single spacing and limit to one page if possible.

B. Additional Service

1. A list and brief description of any additional service to Lake Orion High School and/or the community at large

C. Verification

1. A copy of your college, university, trade or technical school admission letter
2. Activity log of service learning hours
