### Board Positions & Responsibilities

**President** - Preside over and run both Board and General PTO meetings, Approve work of the Board, Support Board members and administration as needed, Represent the school at the district level. **Recommended: Prior PTO Board experience.**

**Major Fundraising** - Plan and execute 2 major fundraising events (1 Fall, 1 Spring), Secure corporate sponsorships, Assist with planning and facilitate Holiday Shoppe. **Recommended: Prior PTO Board or Committee Lead experience.**

**Minor Fundraising** - Plan and execute 2 community events (1 Fall, 1 Spring), Lead Holiday Shoppe planning committee, Manage: Box Tops for Education, Kroger Rewards, Kinder and 5th Grade recognition signs **Prior Board experience not required.**

**Spirit Fundraising** - Plan all spirit-based fundraising efforts, Design spirit wear and facilitate pre-orders, Plan and execute monthly Spirit Shop, Plan and organize monthly Spirit Nights, Assist with planning and facilitate Holiday Shoppe. **Prior Board experience not required.**

**VP Volunteers 1 (3rd & 5th Grade)** - Organize, book, and manage 3rd & 5th grade day events, Facilitate all 5th grade activities: 5th grade shirt, Paw print order & laydown date, 5th Grade Party, 5th Grade Recognition, 5th Grade Walk, 5th Grade Dues, Promote 5th grade yearbook ads, Plan and facilitate Holiday Party. **Prior Board experience not required.**

**VP Volunteers 2 (1st & 4th Grade)** - Organize, book, and manage 1st & 4th grade day events, Create and post volunteer signups for: Chromebook helpers, Picture Days, Science Resource Center (SRC), Library, Ready to Grow Gardens, Clinic volunteers (student measurements), Field Play Day, Plan and facilitate Holiday Party. **Prior Board experience not required.**

**VP Volunteers 3 (PreK, Kinder & 2nd Grade)** - Organize, book, and manage PreK, Kinder, and 2nd Grade day events, Work with administration to plan Kindergarten Meet & Greet, Facilitate prize packaging and delivery for Spikeazon (PBIS Program), Plan and facilitate Holiday Party. **Prior Board experience not required.**

**VP Volunteers 4 (Hospitality)** - Organize back-to-school teacher gifts, Organize back-to-school staff luncheon, Plan monthly staff appreciation treats/breakfasts/luncheons, Organize district appreciation days (bus drivers, librarian, nurses, admin, principals, counselors, psychologist), Plan and organize Teacher Appreciation Week, Facilitate campus beautification requests, Organize Holiday Party and Valentine's Day party snacks (cookie & juice delivery). **Prior Board experience not required.**

**VP of Communications** - Send Remind 101 text communications, Manage Facebook posts, Draft and send monthly PTO Newsletter, Update PTO website as needed, Manage and execute all Spike social media content for Warner Elementary and Warner PTO, Manage yearbook (sales, compilation, photography team), Assist with planning and facilitate Holiday Shoppe. **Prior Board experience not required**


**Treasurer** - Manage accounts receivable and payable, Maintain financial records, banking, and tax filings, Be present for all events involving cash transactions (Spirit Shops, Holiday Shoppe, major events), Assist with planning and facilitate Holiday Shoppe. **Recommended: Accounting experience and familiarity with QuickBooks/Excel. Prior Board experience not required**

**Secretary/Parliamentarian** - Record minutes for General PTO Meetings and Board Meetings, Maintain Lost & Found, Update PTO Bulletin Board monthly, Update Staff Favorites list at beginning of the

year, Promote PTO membership, Regularly check and respond to PTO email account, Manage birthday marquee, Assist with planning and facilitate Holiday Shoppe. **Prior Board experience not required**

## ID Badges required for Bus Transportation



Students can be denied bus access without a badge. **Pg. HB-37 of the student handbook:**

"Each elementary and secondary student is required to have a student ID badge to utilize CFISD transportation. All CFISD students will be issued a student ID badge. IDs will be required each time your child enters and exits their assigned bus. It is the student's responsibility to have their ID badge in their possession and report any malfunction to their campus staff as soon as possible. Please help us enforce this requirement so that your child may take advantage of the privilege to ride the bus. Students who lose or damage their IDs must purchase a new card at the designated area of their home campus. Failure to use the supplied ID will ultimately result in disciplinary action."

## Dress Code and Grooming Guidelines



We want to remind you of the district's dress code and grooming guidelines. Most of the time, students come to school in compliance with the dress code. When violations occur, it is usually the result of the children outgrowing their clothing or too many washings and dryings (causing the clothes to shrink and become too short).

- Bottoms must fit at the waist or upper hip, must not reveal underclothing, and must be mid-thigh in length or longer.
- Tops must not reveal underclothing midsection, torso or back.
- Shoes must not detract from or interfere with the learning environment or present a safety or health hazard. Tennis shoes or closed-toe shoes are preferred. House shoes/house slippers of any kind are not allowed.
- ID Badges are part of the Student Dress Code. The badges and the unique student number will be used to account for students utilizing transportation services, checking out library books and purchasing food items from the cafeteria, providing a means for easy identification of students in common areas of the school and for other uses as determined by campus administration. All Warner students shall wear a student ID badge, visible, on the school-approved lanyards during the instructional day.
