Caps-Enrollment-Transfers

Kerrville Independent School district is committed to providing quality education in a manageable, small class size setting at the elementary school level. Enrollment is limited, or “capped,” at each grade level per campus. The Caps-Enrollment-Transfer Plan continues in effect for the upcoming school year. When enrollment caps are reached, elementary students will be sent to another school within the district where space is available. The student’s confirmed enrollment date determines priority for transfer. KISD provides transportation for students who are required to transfer to another campus. New classes may be formed to achieve a district-wide enrollment balance or to comply with state class-size mandates. School initiated transfers may occur within or between campuses in KISD to achieve these goals.

Complete Online Registration on Skyward Family Access

The most important thing for parents to be aware of is that Kerrville ISD needs to know **now** if your child is planning to attend a Kerrville ISD elementary school next year. Please complete online registration in Skyward Family Access as soon as possible. If you have neighbors or friends enrolling elementary children in KISD for the first time, please pass on this important information. **To secure your child’s seat at your home campus, complete the online registration process early! Registration is dated and timestamped.**

Elementary Campuses will be open July 23rd. If you have moved within or outside the district and your student will be attending a different campus next year, please contact your student’s current campus and provide proof of residency to change your address. All changes to address must go through the student’s current campus. **If there were no changes to your student’s residency, you are not required to call to confirm. When classes fill up, students will be sent to the school with available room.**

Kindergarten Registration

Registration for students who will attend KINDERGARTEN during upcoming school year will be held at each elementary school campus from 8:30-4:00 during March 30th – April 2nd or 5:00 – 6:30 on April 1st. If a student has not previously attended KISD Head-Start or Pre-Kindergarten, a copy of the child’s birth certificate, immunization record, and social security number are required for registration. A “Verification of Address Affidavit” will be required for registration.

New Student Enrollment

Students NEW TO A KERRVILLE ISD ATTENDANCE ZONE will be registered beginning May 4, 2026. Students new to Kerrville will be registered at their home elementary school until the enrollment cap is reached. Students who reside in Kerrville, but are currently enrolled in a homeschool program or in a private school will be registered beginning April 1st.

Change of Residence

Students who change residence within the District during the school year will not transfer to a different elementary campus until the beginning of the following school year.

Grandfather Clause

Students who change residence within the District during their fourth-grade school year will be permitted to remain on the same campus for fifth grade. However, bus **transportation will not be provided**. Siblings may also remain on the same campus, but for only one year.
