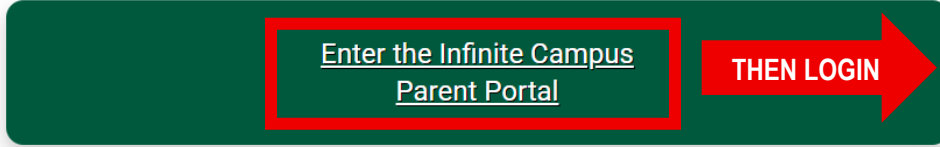


How To Access Georgia Milestones Results – for Parents


